Through daily rehearsals, sight-reading, and performances, students will explore music of various styles, learn to work as part of a team, and gain confidence through musical achievement.

Students will:

- Develop a healthy, resonant tone supported by proper posture and breath control
- Strengthen music literacy skills through solfège, rhythm reading, and sight-reading
- Perform concert repertoire with accuracy, musicality, and expression
- Cultivate teamwork through balance, blend, and listening across the ensemble
- Represent Pearland ISD at concerts, community performances, and TMEA, UIL, and District choir events

- Sing unison and multi-part warm-ups with consistent tone and blend
- Demonstrate control of breath, posture, and intonation across all ranges
- Develop music literacy
- Develop independence in singing harmony parts
- Perform solfège and interval training exercises fluently, with accurate hand signs
- Prepare and perform concert repertoire with stylistic accuracy and musical interpretation
- Perform with a mature, resonant ensemble tone
- Read and perform up to 36 measures of UIL Level 3 sight-reading with accuracy and confidence
- Evaluate and refine musical performances
- Represent Pearland ISD at TMEA Region auditions, UIL Concert & Sight-Reading Contest, and District choir events
- Perform at three or more concerts/community events
- Lead as role models and contributing members of the choir program
