




School breakfast and lunch have been available to all public school students at no cost to families in Michigan starting in the 2023-24 school year. These meals are funded through the state program called Michigan School Meals (MSM). The MSM program is funded yearly on the state fiscal year budget cycle. We are excited to offer meals to all of our students through this program.

Students may receive only one breakfast, and one lunch at no cost per school day. No cost meals must meet certain government guidelines in order for them to qualify. See below:
