HAB had the following feedback:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>consider messaging about all hygiene (other toiletries included such as a toothbrush)</li> <li>perhaps message hygiene in a pamphlet as opposed to samples to give parents choice on the product (brand vs. aluminum free)</li> <li>be sensitive to various cultures and practices</li> <li>be sensitive to allergens</li> </ul> <p>HAB has been passionate regarding the creation of a more robust health curriculum at both middle schools. The high school instructional materials and practices were recently updated in 2021; there is a need to review and bolster middle school practices. Ideas are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>complete a study of peer districts and ascertain when they are doing to support HGD and SEL.</li> <li>look at best-practice for middle school health instruction</li> <li>complete this work from a perspective of student</li> </ul>
