### **Curriculum Notes**

**Math:** Students will use visual models to solve problems involving elapsed time.

**Accelerated Math:** Students will use place value knowledge to compare, order, round, and decompose decimals.

**ELA:** (Grammar & Writing) Students will be able to identify and use possessive nouns correctly. Students will publish and present their expository essays.

**Reading:** Students will comprehend a poem and identify the author's poetry techniques (rhyme, structure, figurative language. Students will identify the mood of a poem.

**Social Studies:** Students will identify and understand the amendments that are the Bill of Rights

**Student Success Skills/ReThink:** Students will learn strategies for respecting our community.
