### South San Antonio ISD – School Bus Guidelines for a Safe Ride

Our goal is to provide a safe, respectful, and comfortable ride for every student. To help us achieve this, please review the following guidelines with your child:

1. **Pickup & Drop-off**
  - o If a pickup time is missed, buses are unable to return.
  - o Students can only be picked up and dropped off at their assigned bus stop.
2. **Food & Drinks**
  - o To help keep the bus safe and clean for everyone, food and drinks should not be consumed while riding.
3. **Caring for the Bus**
  - o Any damage to an SSAISD bus may result in the parent/guardian being financially responsible, and a police report may be filed if necessary.
4. **Safety First**
  - o All parts of a student's body must remain inside the bus at all times.
  - o Throwing objects inside or outside the bus is not allowed.
5. **Prohibited Items**
  - o Items not allowed on school grounds are also not allowed on the bus, including:
    - Alcohol
    - Tobacco
    - Drugs
    - Animals
    - Weapons or anything that could be considered a weapon
