



**The Free Meals for All Students has been renewed in the School Aid Budget for the 2025-2026 school year. Student breakfast and lunch (complete meals, one per student each) will be free this year.*

Meal Charging Policy

An elementary student (Grades K-1) may charge three (3) meals in succession. Once this limit is reached, the student will receive up to two (2) alternative meals. An alternative meal consists of a cheese or peanut butter sandwich, fruit/vegetable, and milk. Each time a student charges a meal, the cashier will inform the student of the delinquent account. Low account balance slips are sent home to parents via email on a weekly basis. Account balances can also be viewed through the "Adding Money to Lunch Accounts and Menus" tab on the Food Service page of the district's website. Individual users can also select to receive low balance alerts via email through Meal Magic, which can be accessed through the same tab as above. No charges will be allowed after Memorial Day, up to two (2) alternative meals will be provided.

An elementary student (Grades 2-4) may charge two (2) meals in succession. Once this limit is reached, the student will receive up to two (2) alternative meals. An alternative meal consists of a cheese or peanut butter sandwich, fruit/vegetable, and milk. Each time a student charges a meal, the cashier will inform the student of the delinquent account. Low account balance slips are sent home to parents via email on a weekly basis. Account balances can also be viewed through the "Adding Money to Lunch Accounts and Menus" tab on the Food Service page of the district's website. Individual users can also select to receive low balance alerts via email through Meal Magic, which can be accessed through the same tab as above. No charges will be allowed after Memorial Day, up to two (2) alternative meals will be provided.

A middle school student (Grades 5-8) may charge one (1) meal in succession. Once this limit is reached, the student will receive up to one (1) alternative meal. An alternative meal consists of a cheese or peanut butter sandwich, fruit/vegetable, and milk. Each time a student charges a meal, the cashier will inform the student of the delinquent account. Low account balance slips are sent home to parents via email on a weekly basis. Account balances can also be viewed through the "Adding Money to Lunch Accounts and Menus" tab on the Food Service page of the district's website. Individual users can also select to receive low balance alerts via email through Meal Magic, which can be accessed through the same tab as above. No charges will be allowed after Memorial Day, up to two (2) alternative meals will be provided.

A high school student (Grades 9-12) may charge one (1) meal in succession. When a student charges a meal, the cashier will inform the student of the delinquent account. Low account balance slips are sent home to parents via email on a weekly basis. Account balances can also be viewed through the "Adding Money to Lunch Accounts and Menus" tab on the Food Service page of the district's website. Individual users can also select to receive low balance alerts via email through Meal Magic, which can be accessed through the same tab as above. No charges will be allowed after Memorial Day.
