To ensure a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all players, coaches, and spectators, Seymour High School has adopted the following spectator rules:

- Backpacks and large bags are discouraged and may be searched at the discretion of the site supervisor.
- No weapons, fireworks, smoke devices, drones, laser pointers, or similar items.
- No alcohol, tobacco, vaping, or e-cigarettes on school property.
- Per CIAC regulations, no air horns, megaphones, or whistles are permitted during the game.
- All spectators must demonstrate positive sportsmanship. Excessive yelling, screaming, or disruptive behavior that distracts players, coaches, or officials is not permitted and may result in removal from the event.
- No masks, face coverings, or concealing hoods.
 - Hoods may not be worn in a manner that conceals or obscures the face. Faces must remain visible to staff and security at all times.
- All spectators must enter the stadium to watch the game. Watching from the outskirts of the field, parking lots, tennis courts, or other campus areas is not permitted.
- Only individuals with an official field or media pass will be permitted entry onto the field at any time; all other spectators must remain in the stands or designated spectator areas.
- Spectators who do not comply with these rules will be required to leave the premises. This policy is in place to maintain safety, proper supervision, and crowd control throughout the event.

Re-Entry Policy: Once an individual under the age of 18 enters the stadium, re-entry is not permitted unless accompanied by an adult. Leaving the stadium otherwise means forfeiting admission for the remainder of the game.

Enforcement

- Seymour on-site staff, security, and law enforcement will enforce all rules.
- A graduated response will be followed:
 - verbal warning with rule reminder → removal from premises → possible long-term ban.
- Spectators who do not comply with these rules will be required to leave the premises.
