Annual Title 1 Meeting

Parent and Family Engagement Trainings

Based on family survey input, we will provide the following activities to assist families in understanding the state curriculum and assessments to help families support their children's academic achievement:

- **3rd - 5th Grade Academic and Behavioral Excellence Training** Parents will participate in the academic and behavioral excellence trainings where they will learn the academic requirements that their students must demonstrate in order to be successful in each subject area for each trimester. Parents will be provided with take-home strategies that they can do with their students in order to build on the progression of knowledge based on the standards.
- **Report Card Night** where parents will meet with teachers to learn about their individual students' strengths and weaknesses, while being provided with specific strategies to help their children enhance their academic proficiency.
- **Stem Night** Parents will rotate through various math and science stations where they will learn how to teach various grade level skills to their children. Every station will have an interactive, hands-on component that will be taught to them. Parents will then be provided with the materials so that they can use these at home with their children.

Shared Decision Making

Parents will be invited to many meetings throughout the year to receive academic information, reports, and provide input on ways the school, families, and students can share responsibility for student success. We hope you will join us for SAC meetings, parent conferences, Title 1 meetings, and parent trainings that will take place at our school.
