



FAIRLEY HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY

- A. TOPS: Shirts and blouses must have sleeves and completely cover the **abdomen, back, and shoulders**. Shirts must cover the waistband of pants, shorts, and skirts with no midriff visible. Low-cut blouses or shirts that are extremely tight or that expose cleavage are prohibited.
- B. Clothing and accessories such as backpacks, patches, jewelry, and notebooks may not display (1) racial or ethnic slurs/symbols; (2) gang affiliations; (3) vulgar, subversive, or sexually suggestive language or images; nor promote inappropriate and/or illegal products such as alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.
- C. No **hats, bonnets, ski mask, durags, wave capes, bandanas, blankets**, hair curlers, picks, or sunglasses will be worn in school.
- D. Skirts, shorts, and dresses must be no shorter than four (4) inches above the knee. No slits or leg openings may be above the middle fingertip. Leggings should be worn with the appropriate outer garment (i.e., shorts, dress, or skirt of proper length.) Skirts must not be tight fitting or revealing. (Bodycon dresses are NOT permitted.)
- E. BOTTOMS: Pants, jeans, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the waist and should fit properly. Pants must be khaki or denim material or dress slacks and worn with a **belt**. **Pajama style pants, sleepwear or blankets** are not permitted. **Pants/Jeans with LARGE holes and slits**, stretch pants, **leggings, tights, jeggings, yoga pants, biker shorts** are strictly prohibited.
- F. Jackets, hoodies, and coats are to be worn in good taste. **Hoods** are not to be worn inside the building.
- G. Students are required to always wear appropriate shoes. All shoes must have heel straps. Shoes with wheels, **slides, house shoes**, Crocs with no back strap, or **flip flops** are not allowed.
- H. Appropriate undergarments must be worn and **not visible**.
- I. Students are to wear clothing in the manner it is designed to be worn, i.e., clothing worn backwards or inside out is not allowed. Excessively tight or revealing clothing, such as see-through garments, are not allowed. Prohibited items include: (1) large, long and/or heavy chains; (2) studded or chained accessories; (3) facial jewelry (including tongue piercing).

The principal shall have the discretion to outline other appropriate guidelines for their campus or for special occasions.
