TESTING INFORMATION

- **PSAT/ED-OPTION DAY is October 21st.** On this day, each grade level will participate in a different educational option experience related to college and career. For many of our students, this is the day they will take the PSAT/NMSQT to assess their current level of college readiness. Other students will have the option to engage in an activity that will provide them with further insight about themselves and/or their chosen career path.
 - 9th Grade - YouScience assessment and activity (must bring school Chromebook). **Students will be dismissed at 10:45 A.M.**
 - 10th Grade - Digital PSAT (must bring school Chromebook CHARGED).
 - **Students will be dismissed at 10:45 A.M.**
 - 11th Grade - Digital PSAT. **Students will be dismissed at 10:45 A.M.** (must bring school Chromebook CHARGED); or Ed-OptionDay experience (college visit, service/volunteer, or job shadow). Only juniors taking the PSAT should report to school.
 - 12th Grade - Ed-Option experience. **Seniors do not report to school.**

Apply Now for Free and Reduced School Meals

Free and reduced meal applications are available online in the [Payschools Parent Portal](#). Additionally, paper applications are available in the school front offices. A new application is required each school year to determine eligibility for free or reduced meals; there is only a 30-day grace period from last school year's approval.

Instructional Fee Waiver: Prior to electronically signing and submitting the online application, please make sure to "check" the boxes in the disclosure section if you are also requesting an instructional fee waiver. This is an important step, as fees will not be waived without this authorization.

For families who are directly certified for free or reduced meals due to their eligibility through SNAP, TANF or Medicaid, you will receive a Direct Certification Notification from our Nutrition Services Partner, Milford Exempted Village Schools.

Please note that action is required - you must sign and return the Fee Waiver Permission on the bottom of that form - in order for instructional fees to be waived.
