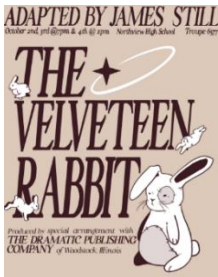


4 Pillars – Positive Attitude – September 29th

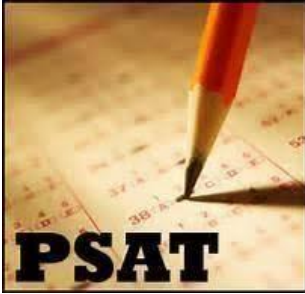

PSAT Administration – Tuesday, October 7 (All students, grades 9-11)

On Tuesday, October 7, all students in grades 9 through 11 will participate in PSAT testing at Northview High School. The PSAT serves as a valuable tool in preparing students for the SAT and provides important data to support academic planning. Additionally, Fulton County Schools utilizes PSAT results as a universal screener; therefore, participation is mandatory for all students in these grade levels.

Grade-Level Assessments:

- 9th Grade: PSAT 8/9
- 10th & 11th Grades: PSAT/NMSQT

Testing will begin promptly at 8:20 AM and is expected to conclude by approximately 12:15 PM. Students are required to use their FCS-issued devices for testing. To ensure a smooth testing experience, multiple device checks will be conducted prior to test day.

Senior Students: Seniors will have an asynchronous learning day and will not report to campus.

Additional Information: Students who remain on campus after testing will have access to academic support activities, including recovery, remediation, help sessions, and study hall for work completion.

SAT School Day- Wednesday, October 8, 2025 (Seniors only)

We are pleased to offer senior students the opportunity to participate in a free administration of the SAT School Day on Wednesday, October 8. This is a valuable chance for students to take the SAT in a familiar school setting, without the need for weekend testing.

Key Details:

- Eligibility: Students must be classified as seniors to participate.
- Start Time: Testing will begin promptly at 8:20 AM.
- Duration: The SAT is approximately 3.5 hours.
- Device Requirement: Students must use their FCS-issued device for testing. Multiple device checks will be conducted prior to test day to ensure optimal performance.

Deadline: Registration closes on Thursday, October 2 at 11:59 PM. Late registrations will not be accepted.

Schedule for Non-Participants: Seniors who do not register for the SAT will follow a regular class schedule on October 8. Students who complete the SAT will resume their regular classes for the remainder of the school day.
