Caleb Everett

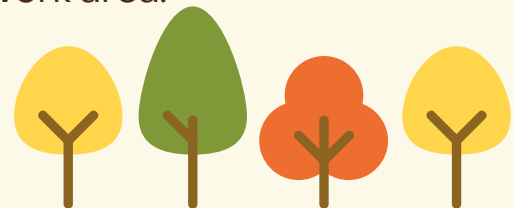

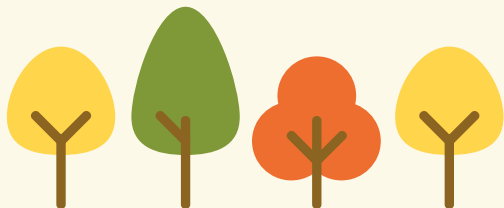
Michael Bixler
