Dear Wyoming Staff and Community,

September was another busy and productive month as we continue moving forward with our Primary Facilities Construction Project. Below are a few highlights from the past several weeks and a look ahead at upcoming milestones:

Hilltop School

- Construction fencing is now installed around the Hilltop site, incorporating the existing playground fence along Riley.
- The demolition permits from both the City of Wyoming and Hamilton County have been approved, and demolition is scheduled to begin soon.
- Staff and community members will have the opportunity to collect bricks from Hilltop as a keepsake; more details will be shared soon.

Elm School

- Soil borings have been completed to evaluate site conditions. These results will help guide design and construction planning.
- The second Elm School Design Workshop is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 15, at Elm School, where we'll be gathering additional design input. All are invited!

Vermont School

- The first Vermont School Design Workshop is scheduled for 6:30 p.m. Monday, November 10, at Vermont School, where we will be gathering ideas and listening to everyone's thoughts about what should be considered when designing the new Vermont School. All are invited!
