✔ Project Lifesaver with the Bayonne Police Department

The Bayonne Police Department implemented the Project Lifesaver Program to provide enhanced support and assistance to Bayonne residents who are primary caregivers for an individual suffering from Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia disorder as well as families of children afflicted with Down syndrome, autism, traumatic brain injuries or cognitive impairments.

These individuals might be prone to wander away from home and become confused or lost. Project Lifesaver allows for a proactive response by the Bayonne Police Department if this happens. This not only saves time and manpower but also, gives caregivers and families peace of mind and reassurance that all possible resources will be utilized in the effort to locate and return their loved one home safely. **Participants in the Project Lifesaver program wear a special wrist bracelet equipped with a small transmitter which emits a signal that we can track when someone goes missing.** Search times have been reduced from days and hours to minutes.





✓ **Hudson County's Blue Envelope Program.**

Through the program, individuals are provided with a blue envelope to store personal identification to give to an officer during a law enforcement encounter, whether it be a traffic stop or a pedestrian in need of emergency assistance. The envelope provides law enforcement with immediate information about sensory disorders to reduce the likelihood of miscommunication.

✓ **AngelSense**

What is AngelSense? AngelSense is an assistive technology that includes a **proactive** monitoring & alerting system, an **app** for caregivers, and a wearable **device** with an auto-pickup speakerphone and SOS button. Maximum Safety and Independence for Autism, Special Needs & Dementia. AngelSense is an assistive technology for maximum safety, effective remote support, and increased independence.
