Shout Out to Mr. Matt Jones!

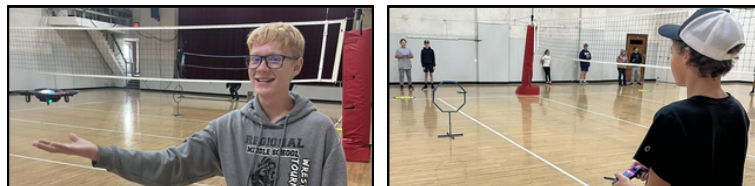

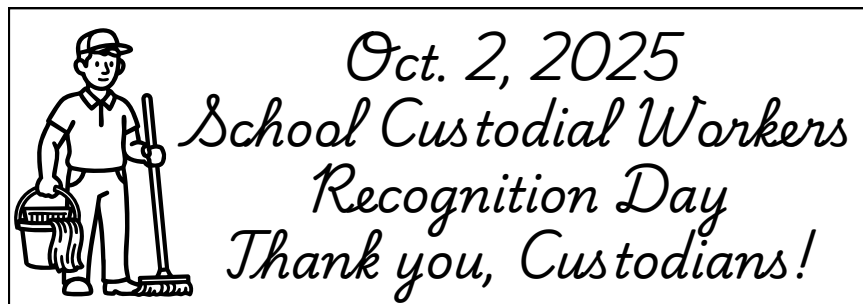
