In compliance with [Board Policy 2135 Human Sexuality Instruction and Identity Instruction](#), this message serves as notice that students will participate in a unit on human development the week of *November 17-21, 2025*. This lesson will be taught in a co-ed setting.

The human sexuality instruction is intended to be taught to your child:

- Healthy and Unhealthy Relationships
- Reproductive Systems (Male & Female)
- Personal Health (Pregnancy, Abstinence, Contraception, and Sexually Transmitted Diseases/Infections)

We will not be discussing:

- Sexual Orientation
- Gender Identity
- Abortion
- Sexual Acts

A committee of teachers, parents, school nurses, and administrators designed the human development and sexuality materials for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. The committee's goal was to design an age-appropriate health enhancement curriculum that is age-appropriate and equips students with the skills and knowledge to make healthy decisions.

Parents/guardians have the right to withdraw their child from Hellgate Elementary School's human sexuality instruction. If you wish to excuse your child from this portion of the curriculum, you may complete the written request below and return it to your child's principal.
