MINUTES

Santa Ana Board of Education
Regular Board Meeting

Tuesday, August 26, 2025

1. CALL TO ORDER

President Bustos called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.

Other Board Members in attendance were Ms. Brazer Aceves, Ms. Magdaleno, Dr. Alvarez, and Ms. Lebsack.

Mr. Bustos announced closed session items including Conference with Labor Negotiators, Personnel Matters, Anticipated Litigation, and Real Property Negotiators.

There was no one wishing to address Board related to closed session items.

2. RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION

The Regular Board meeting recessed to closed session at 5:02 p.m.

3. RECONVENE TO REGULAR MEETING

The Regular Board meeting reconvened at 6:23 p.m.

Cabinet members in attendance were Dr. Perez, Ms. Flores, Mr. Hacker, and Mr. Bustamante with Ms. Barquin absent.

4. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Ethan Castellanos, a 4th grade student at King Elementary School, led the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Mr. Bustos read the following statement: I want to recognize that our District and school campuses are located in the Village of Pasbenga. I want to acknowledge that this land we refer to as Orange County, is the unceded and traditional lands of the Gabrielino Tongva Nation, and the Juaneño Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation. These lands were taken through a process of colonization, physical, and cultural genocide. I want to pay my respect to elders, both past and present, as well as the Tongva and Acjachemen Youth who have attended, are currently attending our schools, or in the neighboring districts.

7. RECOGNITION/ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

7.1 Life Saving Award - Recognition of District Safety Officers Vince Gonzales, Alex Cruz and Yvette Flores

Dr. Perez introduced the recognition portion of the meeting and invited the District's Chief Sergio Mancilla to present. Three District Safety Officers were honored with Lifesaving Awards for their swift and coordinated response to a choking incident involving a student on September 12, 2024. Their actions ensured the student's safety and recovery without the need for hospital transport.

8. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Superintendent's report highlighted several key achievements and statistics from the Santa Ana Unified School District (SAUSD). Notably, the District celebrated a 92% graduation rate for the class of 2025, with 71% of the class of 2024 now enrolled in college. Additionally, 47% of graduates were eligible for California State University admission, and 24% earned the Seal of Biliteracy. The report emphasized the importance of college and career readiness, with a focus on improving reading skills and supporting English learners. The Superintendent expressed pride in the accomplishments of SAUSD students, particularly those attending prestigious universities, and reiterated the District's commitment to transparency and community engagement regarding class sizes and staffing changes.

President Bustos directed Dr. Perez to report on concerns about staffing, class changes, dual language programs, and to join a listening session with the King Elementary School community.

14. BOARD REPORTS

Ms. Lebsack expressed appreciation for Dr. Perez's presentation on student outcomes and staffing updates. She highlighted visits to Advanced Learning Academy and Carver Elementary and attendance at the Santa Ana Chicano Heritage Festival. She raised concerns about discrepancies in combo class reporting at King Elementary School and questioned the lack of transportation for middle school sports. Additional inquiries included the reassignment of curriculum specialists, implications of a recent Supreme Court ruling on curriculum opt-outs, and the need for updated research in policymaking, particularly around gender-affirming care.

Dr. Alvarez shared his experience at Madison's Back-to-School Night and acknowledged community concerns on dual emergent and combo classes and staffing. He emphasized the need for clearer communication on enrollment figures and urged the District to find solutions for sports transportation. He also reaffirmed the legal requirement for identity support plans and requested a departmental dialogue on dyslexia and special education services.

Ms. Magdaleno thanked community speakers and acknowledged ongoing challenges related to displacement and language programs. She expressed interest in joining the upcoming meeting at King Elementary, requested updates on afterschool program funding, and echoed the call for more information on dyslexia services.

Ms. Brazer Aceves recapped school site visits and participation in District events, including a family preparedness workshop. She commended parent advocacy on dyslexia screening and requested comparisons with existing District plans. She also asked for clarification on combo classes, including best practices and communication strategies.

Mr. Bustos addressed community concerns on displacement and class sizes, noting that such issues recur annually due to enrollment shifts, though this year's reduction in force has heightened sensitivity. He reaffirmed the District's commitment to addressing concerns through collaboration. He also reported attending immigration roundtables and promoted a local immigration resource event. Additional remarks included appreciation for Esqueda Elementary's Back-to-School Night, and support for enhanced dyslexia services and special education leadership.



10 WHEREAS, National Latino, Latina, and Latinx Heritage Month, observed annually
11 from September 15 to October 15, acknowledges the rich history, culture, and
12 contributions of Latin American communities in the United States and globally; and
13

14 WHEREAS, this period is historically significant as it marks the anniversaries
15 of independence from Spain of several Latin American nations, including Costa Rica,
16 El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua on September 15, Mexico on September
17 16, and Chile on September 18, with others like Belize on September 21; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the recognition of this month highlights the depth of the struggle
20 for independence, self-determination, and the ongoing resistance against colonial
21 and neo-colonial forces that these nations have endured; and
22

23 WHEREAS, the diverse and vibrant Latin American communities in the United
24 States, including those identifying as Latino, Latina, and/or Latinx, are heirs to
25 a legacy of Latinidad defined as the shared cultural pride, resilience, creativity,
26 and interconnectedness of peoples of Latin American heritage, which continues to
27 enrich and shape our nation; and
28

29 WHEREAS, current immigration debates, policies, and enforcement activities
30 across the nation, including in our own community, underscore the urgent need to
31 reaffirm that SAUSD schools remain safe havens and welcoming spaces for all students
32 and families regardless of immigration status; and
33

34 WHEREAS, it is critical to engage in a process of reclaiming and redefining
35 this month through a lens that prioritizes historical truth, acknowledges the

36 complexity of Latin American identities, and centers the voices and experiences of
37 those who have been marginalized by dominant narratives; and

38

39 WHEREAS, National Latino, Latina, and Latinx Heritage Month should serve not
40 only as a celebration of cultural heritage but also as an opportunity to critically
41 examine and address the socio-political conditions that continue to impact Latin
42 American communities, including the challenges faced by immigrant families in
43 accessing education, resources, and support without fear of harassment or
44 discrimination; and

46 WHEREAS, this reclamation effort aligns with the broader struggle for
47 educational and social justice, equity, and the affirmation of the humanity of all
48 people, particularly those of Latin American descent, by challenging the Master
49 Narrative and promoting the Counter-Narrative that highlights the resilience,
50 creativity, and contributions of these communities; and

52 WHEREAS, this reclamation encourages the SAUSD community to celebrate and
53 provide opportunities for Latino, Latina, and Latinx and all students to nurture
54 and grow their cultural and linguistic heritage as assets; and

56 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Board of Education, recognizes
57 September 15 to October 15, 2025, as National Latino, Latina, and Latinx Heritage
58 Month, and encourages teachers, other staff members, students and the community to
59 use this opportunity to honor the contributions of our Latino/a/x population with
60 pride in their Latinidad; and

62 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that this month shall be observed with an emphasis on
63 fostering historical consciousness, encouraging the study and dissemination of the
64 histories, cultures, and contributions of Latino, Latina, and Latinx communities,
65 and promoting dialogues that address the ongoing struggles for justice, equity,
66 immigration rights, and liberation; and

68 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that this resolution serves as a commitment to uplift
69 the voices of Latino, Latina, and Latinx communities, ensuring that their heritage
70 is recognized not as a monolithic culture, but as a diverse and dynamic force that
