About Hebron: Established in 1899, Hebron School is an independently managed, multicultural international, co-educational residential school. Hebron School broadly follows the structure of the English National Curriculum, culminating in the International General Certificate of Secondary Education examinations (Standard 11), and the General Certificate of Education Advanced Level - AS examinations (Standard 12) and A2 (Standard 13). The school situated in Ooty, adjacent to the Botanical Garden is a lively, busy community in which gifts and talents of both staff and students have ample opportunity for expression and development.

Job Summary:

We are seeking a passionate and dedicated drum teacher to join the music department. The ideal candidate will provide individual acoustic and electric guitar instruction, support bands, and organise musical productions. In addition to teaching guitar techniques and rhythm, the role includes preparing students for internal and external exams such as ABRSM or Trinity. As part of our boarding school community, the teacher will also be involved in dormitory responsibilities and Christian activities.

Responsibilities:

- **Deliver Guitar Instruction:** Teach individual and group lessons on acoustic and electric guitar to students across a range of skill levels.
- **Exam Preparation:** Prepare students for graded music exams with ABRSM or Trinity as appropriate.
- **Band Support:** Work collaboratively with student bands, focusing on performance coaching, repertoire development, and rehearsal techniques.
- **Enrichment Activities:** Support and lead extracurricular music activities, such as guitar clubs, jam sessions, or ensemble rehearsals.
- **Musical Productions:** Assist with the musical direction and performance aspects of school productions, where guitar is required.
- **Curriculum Contribution:** Contribute to the development of teaching resources and support GCSE and Alevel composition and practical recordings.
- **Professional Development:** Engage in ongoing professional learning and contribute positively to departmental meetings and initiatives.
