# SHAWN GRUSENDORF

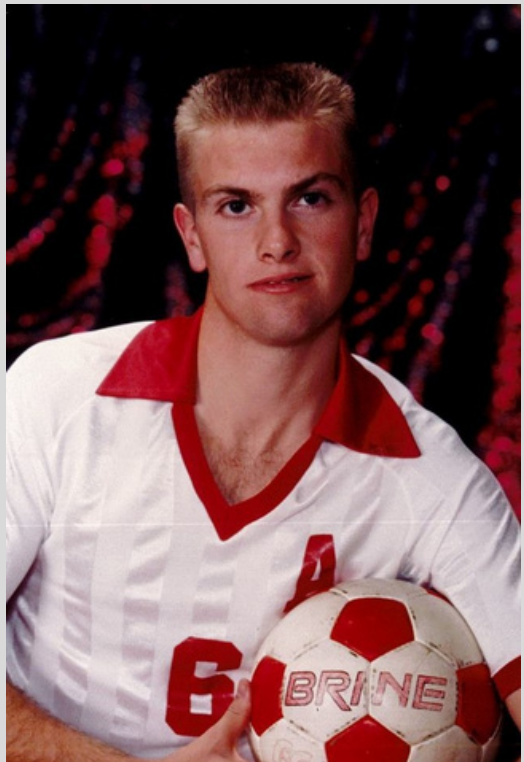
ANGELICA CENTRAL SCHOOL (1993)

Shawn Grusendorf, a 1993 graduate of Angelica Central School, was a three-sport athlete who excelled in soccer, basketball, and baseball throughout his high school career.

By his junior year, he had established himself as a varsity athlete in all three sports, and he earned the opportunity to represent the county as a member of the New York Select Team through the Eurosports Network, competing internationally in England, France, Belgium, and Germany.

As a senior, Shawn helped lead his soccer team to an Allegany County Division II title and was named County MVP in soccer as well as Outstanding Male Senior Athlete.

After graduating, Shawn attended Alfred State before beginning a career in law enforcement. He has served the Allegany County Sheriff's Department in a variety of roles, including Correction Officer, Deputy Sheriff, Sergeant, and Lieutenant.



# KRISTEN HUNTER

BELMONT CENTRAL SCHOOL (1990)

Kristen Hunter, a 1990 graduate of Belmont Central School, was a standout three-sport athlete, competing in varsity soccer, basketball, and softball for four years. On the soccer field, she was a three-time Section V champion, earned Co-MVP honors of the county her senior year, and was named an Allegany County South Division First Team All-Star. She also played overseas with the Greater Rochester Area All-Star Team, traveling to Europe for international competition. Kristen was recognized as a Class D All-Star in basketball and a Second Team All-Star in softball. At graduation, she received numerous honors, including the American Legion Citizenship Award, Rotary Fellowship Award, Musicianship Award, and Outstanding Attitude Award.

After earning her associate degree from Alfred State in 1992, Kristen continued her passion for soccer by playing collegiately for one year and later competing in women's leagues after moving to Rochester. She also gave back to the game as a coach at Belmont, leading JV girls soccer and softball for a season, and has since been active in youth sports through Arcadia Sports Boosters and as a manager of travel soccer teams. Today, Kristen serves as Executive Assistant for the Department of Pediatrics at Rochester General Hospital.

# CYNTHIA HUMPHREY

GENESEE VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL (2011)

Cynthia Humphrey, a 2011 graduate of Genesee Valley Central School, was a versatile athlete who competed in volleyball, basketball, softball, and track & field. She earned multiple Allegany County All-Star honors across three sports and was named a Section V All-Star in volleyball in 2011. On the track, Cynthia excelled in the 400m hurdles, winning Section V championships in 2010 and 2011 and breaking the Section V record in the event both years. Beyond athletics, she was also an active student leader, participating in National Honor Society, FBLA, all-county choir, and drama club.

Cynthia continued her athletic pursuits at SUNY Potsdam, where she earned a bachelor's degree in Anthropology in 2016 and played on the women's rugby team. She now resides in Charleston, South Carolina, where she works at Topgolf as a bartender.

# CODY SCHNEIDER

GENESEE VALLEY CENTRAL SCHOOL (2020)

Cody Schneider, a 2020 graduate of Genesee Valley Central School, left his mark as a standout multi-sport athlete. A three-sport League All-Star, Cody excelled in soccer, basketball, and baseball, earning recognition as both a Great 8 and Big 30 All-Star. On the court, he set GVCS records for career points and rebounds, cementing his place in program history. In addition to his athletic achievements, he was a dedicated student and a member of the National Honor Society.



Following graduation, Cody continued his basketball career, playing two years at Mansfield University before transferring to Alfred State. At Alfred, he was named Newcomer of the Year and a 2nd Team All-Conference selection as a junior, and capped off his senior season with 1st Team All-Conference honors. He graduated from Alfred State in 2024 with a degree in Criminal Justice.

# 2016 GVCS VARSITY BASEBALL TEAM

The 2016 Genesee Valley Central School Varsity Baseball Team made history with an unforgettable postseason run that carried them to the New York State Final Four. Led by head coach Eric Weinman and assistant coaches Steve Biancuzzo and John Zlomek, the Jaguars finished the regular season 11-5 and entered sectionals as the No. 2 seed. The team captured the Section V title with a win over Batavia Notre Dame before falling in the state semifinal to the eventual state champions.
