

Policy Type: Executive Limitations

Instructional Materials Selection

The Superintendent shall not fail to adopt textbooks and instructional materials that advance the achievement of the Board's *Results* policies and contribute toward continuity, integration and articulation of the curriculum by course and program.

Accordingly, the Superintendent shall not:

1. Fail to ensure appropriate input from the following groups as instructional materials are reviewed and selected: teachers, administrators and other staff members involved in developing the education program. Students will be involved when appropriate.
2. Fail to consider the needs of all learners when selecting textbooks and instructional materials and assure alignment with district curriculum standards.
3. Fail to provide a procedure for the evaluation of materials and textbooks, and a procedure for reviewing such materials upon formal request by a parent or citizen
4. Fail to develop and implement appropriate policies governing access to and utilization of electronically distributed information

Monitoring Method: Internal report
Monitoring Frequency: Annually in February
