

We are extremely proud that our schools have received high ratings, and our students earn prestigious national honors. Recent recognitions include:

- U.S. News & World Report ranked Manhasset High School **No. 4 on Long Island** and **No. 23 in New York State** in its list of 2025 rankings of best high schools.
- In 2024, U.S. News & World Report ranked Manhasset Middle School **No. 28** out of 2,900 middle schools in New York State.
- Manhasset Secondary School and Munsey Park Elementary School have been designated as **Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence** by the U.S. Department of Education.
- Six members of the Class of 2025 were named **winners** in the **National Merit Scholarship Program**.
- Two Manhasset High School students were named **2025 Regeneron STS Scholars**.
- Six Manhasset High School students were candidates for the **U.S. Presidential Scholars Program** with one selected as a winner.
- For 17 years, the district has been named a **Best Community for Music Education** by the NAMM Foundation.

POINTS OF PRIDE



Alongside national recognition for our schools, our students excel and receive accolades in academics, the arts and athletics at all levels. In addition to the highlights noted on Page 2, here are just a few of the many Points of Pride we celebrate!

- In 2024, Manhasset Secondary School earned Platinum recognition on College Board's Advanced Placement School Honor Roll, the highest level of distinction that a school can receive.
- A total of 180 Manhasset High School students were named AP Scholars by the College Board in 2025, including 54 AP Scholars, 12 AP Scholars with Honor and 120 AP Scholars with Distinction.
- Manhasset High School boasts 228 recipients of the Presidential Volunteer Service Award.
- Seven student musicians from Manhasset Secondary School were selected in 2024 to participate in the New York State School Music Association All-State Music Festival.
- Virtual Enterprise class was awarded "Circle of Excellence," one of 26 schools nationwide to earn this distinction.
- A student journalist was selected as a 2025 Roger Rees Award finalist.
- Members of the Manhasset Broadcasting Company at Manhasset High School were recognized with multiple awards by the National Student Television Network.
- Two student artists were selected for "Long Island's Best High School Artist exhibition, with one earning Best in Show award.
- Manhasset Secondary School was named a 2024-25 School of Distinction by the New York State Public High School Athletics Association, an acknowledgement that 100% of its 31 teams earned Scholar-Athlete Team status.
- Manhasset High School student was named Greater NYC Affiliate Winner of the NCWIT Aspirations in Computing High School Award.
- Student-athletes earned championship trophies in boys and girls golf, cross-country and track and field, tennis, swim, lacrosse, wrestling, fencing and more.
