Our Approach

At Westside School, we believe that learning is a dynamic, student-centered process where learners engage deeply with content, reflect on their experiences, and connect ideas across disciplines. Through inquiry-based exploration, students develop autonomy and a strong sense of self. Our curriculum emphasizes active, collaborative learning. Students consider diverse perspectives, construct meaning, and continually challenge and refine their thinking in the classroom and beyond.

PLAY-BASED LEARNING

For early learners, play is learning. Our emergent, play-based curriculum focuses on experiential learning, fostering the social-emotional foundations essential for academic growth. What looks like play is actually students building social, cognitive, and problemsolving skills that will support them from early learning through 8th grade and beyond.



Teachers observe children's spontaneous interests and guide them toward projects and activities that spark curiosity. Classroom learning stations, combined with whole and small group activities, promote each child's social and academic development.



SPECIALISTS & ENRICHMENT

In addition to daily classroom experiences, students participate in physical education, the arts, and world languages (Spanish and Mandarin), connecting with cultures, discovering their unique interests, and developing a love of learning.







LEARNING, COMMUNITY, AND INCLUSION

Our youngest learners explore the outdoors, play on the playground, visit local neighborhoods, and connect with older buddies through fun school activities. These experiences build confidence and help children develop social skills, cooperation, and a sense of belonging. From the start, children also learn empathy, respect for others, and age-appropriate lessons about identity and fairness, helping them grow into confident and caring community members.



ACADEMIC & SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

Children receive personalized academic support through small groups and guided activities, while social-emotional learning helps them understand themselves, build friendships, and practice kindness and responsibility. With one counselor and one learning specialist, Westside combines play, academic learning, and social-emotional growth to help each child thrive in a welcoming, inclusive community.

EARLY LEARNING OVERVIEW

Program: Play-based, experiential learning that fosters curiosity, creativity, early academic skills, and social-emotional growth. Students engage in hands-on activities, outdoor exploration, enrichment specialists, and ageappropriate SEL that builds self-awareness, empathy, and strong relationships.

Grades Served: Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten

Class Size: ~15 Students

Teachers: Lead Teacher + 1-2 Instructional Assistants in each room.

LEARNING BY DOING

In Lower School, students learn by doing. From hands-on projects and classroom activities to outdoor explorations and field trips, they explore real-world applications of what they learn. Teachers encourage curiosity, creativity, and collaboration, helping students become confident, independent thinkers who see learning as an exciting journey. Lessons mix collaboration, independent work, and presentations, helping students develop the skills and confidence to share their ideas with peers, teachers, and the wider community.



SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL GROWTH

Social-emotional learning is woven into every part of the school day. Through guided activities and meaningful conversations, students build empathy, self-regulation, and respect for others. They develop strong friendships, practice cooperation, and gain confidence, all of which support their academic growth and overall well-being.



A DYNAMIC, EVOLVING CURRICULUM

Westside's curriculum is flexible, dynamic, and evolving. Teachers collaborate and reflect regularly to create meaningful, engaging lessons that stay current with best practices and respond to students' needs. As an independent school, Westside can innovate and adapt, offering a program designed to support each child's growth and provide **authentic,** student-centered learning experiences.



LEARNING THROUGH LEADERSHIP

As part of a PS-8th-grade school community, Lower School students have unique opportunities to develop leadership and mentorship skills. Students learn from older buddies through guided activities, shared projects, and school-wide events, while also practicing empathy, responsibility, and collaboration as they serve as role models for their younger classmates.



A DAY IN LOWER SCHOOL

A typical day in Lower School balances learning, exploration, and community. Students begin with Morning Meeting to connect and set intentions for the day. They move through core lessons in reading, math, science, and social studies, along with specialist classes like music, art, P.E., and world languages. Recess and snack time provide time to recharge and enjoy friendships. The day ends with Closing Circle, where students reflect, celebrate accomplishments, and prepare for tomorrow.

LOWER SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Program: In Lower School, students grow as curious, independent learners in a hands-on, project-based environment. Teachers guide learning, foster social-emotional growth, and build confidence. Students develop leadership and mentorship skills through buddy programs and collaborative activities, while local explorations provide meaningful, real-world learning every day.

Grades Served: Kindergarten - 4th Grade

Class Size: ~20 Students

Teachers: 2 Lead Teachers + 1-2 Instructional Assistants in each grade. Student Support: 1 Counselor and 2 Learning Support Specialists.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Empowered Leaders, Confident Learners

Middle School at Westside empowers students to think critically and lead confidently, preparing them for high school and beyond.





MIDDLE SCHOOL AT WESTSIDE

Westside's Middle School empowers students to explore their passions, develop critical thinking, and grow as confident, compassionate learners. Our program combines hands-on rigorous academics, arts, social-emotional learning, and real-world experiences, giving students ownership of their learning. Older students also have opportunities to serve as mentors to younger buddies, building leadership skills while supporting the school community.



EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING & TRIPS

Experiential education is at the heart of Middle School. Students engage in hands-on projects, field trips, service learning, and outdoor experiences that connect classroom learning to the world around them. Middle School students participate in two multi-day outdoor adventures each year, building bonds with their peers, learning teamwork, problem-solving, and how to navigate new challenges.



ADVISORY & SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING

The Middle School Advisory Program pairs each student with a dedicated advisor in a closeknit, grade-level group for the full year. Meeting daily, advisors guide students' social, emotional, and academic growth. SEL and Social Justice instruction help students develop self-awareness, relationship skills, social responsibility, and confidence in their learning.



EXPLORATION & ENRICHMENT

Middle School students at Westside have many opportunities to explore their interests and develop new skills. Students take exploratory and specialist classes in world language, technology, visual arts, music, and more, while the Theater Club produces two annual shows. Our athletics program—including soccer, cross country, volleyball, basketball, and track & field—is "no cut" and emphasizes teamwork, sportsmanship, and fun. Together, these experiences help build creativity, confidence, collaboration, and leadership.



ACADEMIC & LEARNING SUPPORT

Westside's academic support team provides small-group instruction, differentiated learning, and targeted interventions to meet each student's unique needs. Support includes helping students in areas of challenge, stretching them in areas of strength, and addressing attention or executive functioning skills.

MIDDLE SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Program: Our Middle School curriculum combines hands-on academics, arts, exploratory classes, athletics, and real-world experiences. With advisory support, socialemotional learning, and academic guidance, students thrive socially, emotionally, and academically, developing confidence, leadership skills, and readiness for high school and beyond.

Grades Served: 5th-8th Grade Class Size: ~20 Students

Student Leadership: Service learning, buddy program, and student leadership club opportunities.

Student Support: 1 counselor and 2 learning support specialists.
