Licensing Requirements:

To be eligible to substitute teach in D181, you must hold one of the following licenses registered in DuPage County:

- **Certified Teacher Substitute:** Illinois Professional Educator License (PEL) or Substitute Teaching License
- **Instructional Assistant Substitute:** ELS (PARA) License or STA (Short-Term Approval) License

- Bring original I-9 documents and official college transcripts (certified teachers only) to your interview.
