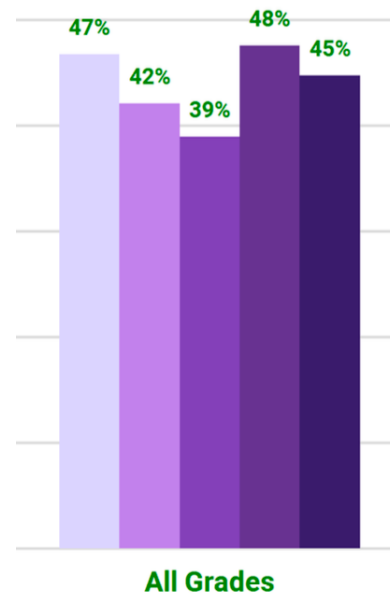

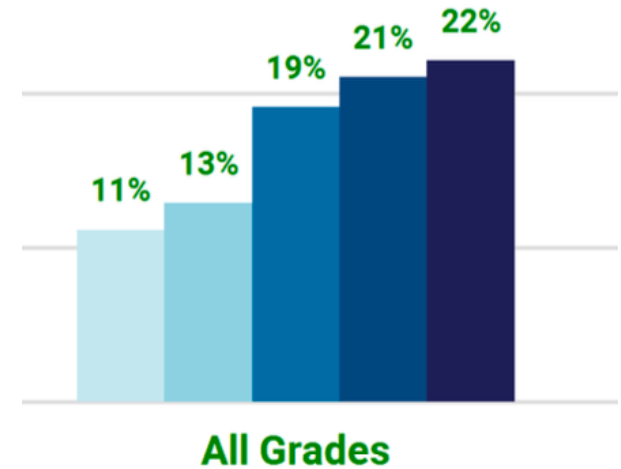


Data Analysis Summary

- Math scores up 62% of total points over 3 years
- ELA scores have hit a flat point. 98% of the reporting districts (reported by LinkIt!) have shown a decrease in ELA scores.
- Science testing was in a field study. Previous testing showed a 16% increase over 2 years.
- Targeted Intervention for 60 students regarding attendance.

Blueprint for Success: Mathematics

Target: *We will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced on the LinkIt! Benchmarks by 8% as compared to the previous three-year average.*

Action Plan:

- *Tier 1*
 - *Fully implemented Envision math resources*
 - *Use of IXL skill building*
 - *Maintain current proficient and advanced students through targeted intervention as needed.*
- *Tier 2*
 - *Small group intervention through the Flex period.*
 - *Partnered skills approach (Math/Science/EA)*
 - *Intervention cycles between benchmarks*



Blueprint for Success: English Language Arts

Target: We will increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or advanced on the LinkIt! Benchmarks by 8% as compared to the previous three-year average.

Action Plan:

- *Tier 1*
 - *Common Assessments of writing (grade 6-8)*
 - *IXL Skill-building*
 - *Literacy strategies in ELA and Social Studies classes*
 - *Grade Level Alignment (6-8 common strategy)*
- *Tier 2*
 - *Partnered Intervention (ELA, Social Studies, EA staff)*
 - *Targeted Intervention through the Flex period*
 - *Intervention cycles between benchmarks*



Blueprint for Success: School Climate

Target: Middle school implementation of Rounding will have 100% completion by the end of the 2025-2026 school year.

Action Plan:

- *Tier 1*
 - *All staff will have rounding conversations with a supervisor.*
 - *Development of multiple stoplight reports*
- *Tier 2*
 - *Select group of staff will participate in Problem of Practice Rounding*
 - *Develop action steps to Problem of Practice*
 - *Involve CIP team for future planning.*



Blueprint for Success: Attendance Improvement

Target: Decrease the number of truant students by 10%.

- *67 students required a 10-day attendance letter and SAIP conference.*
- *7 students left the district.*
- *Targeting 60 students this year.*
- *Action Plan:*
 - *Tier 1*
 - *Team attendance intervention through Advisory*
 - *Expanded student recognition*
 - *Team expectations attached to attendance*
 - *Tier 2*
 - *Attendance Initiative (School Counselor Led)*
 - *SAIP conference attendance improved*
 - *Increased parent teacher conferences*



Points of Pride

- *New master schedule with restructured Flex period*
- *Added Advisory period to enhance student connection to staff.*
- *New Planetarium Material*
- *Decreased summer school needs by half.*
- *Success in Student Organizations*
 - *TSA to states*
 - *What's So Cool About Manufacturing*
 - *Quiz Bowl*
- *62% increase in total score in math over 3 years.*
