



Project SEARCH Transition-to-Work Program Basic Entrance Criteria

The applicant:

School Status

- Is at least 18 years of age, has not graduated from high school, is on an IEP, and has an identified intellectual or developmental disability
- Will have finished their high school program or credits needed to graduate
- Has agreed that Project SEARCH will be their last year of school, and has the goal of working at the end of the program

Agency Services

- Would benefit from personalized support in an intensive year of career development internship experience and
- Is eligible for (*Vocational Rehabilitation state agency*)
- Is eligible for (*Developmental Disabilities state or local organization*) (if required)

Personal Skills

- Accepts feedback and can change behavior with teaching
- Will be able to follow the rules (policies, procedures, and guidelines) of the host business
- Will complete travel training to ensure they are able to get to/from and around the host business by themselves, and will use public transportation when available
- Is committed to working in the community (at least 16 hours per week) at the end of the program

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
