- October 11, 2024: All 10th-grade students from Hutchinson and Glencoe-Silver Lake (GSL) attended the Ignite Your Future conference at Ridgewater College in Hutchinson, Minnesota. This event provided students with opportunities to explore local educational programs and career pathways available within the region.
- November 20, 2024: All 5th-grade students from Hutchinson and GSL attended a performance of *How the Grinch Stole Christmas* at the Minnesota Children's Theatre, offering a shared cultural experience that supported literacy and arts appreciation.
- April 11, 2025: All 8th-grade students from Hutchinson and GSL participated in a Career Expo hosted at Glencoe-Silver Lake High School by the School Communities group. The event featured local businesses and community partners who showcased career opportunities within the Glencoe–Hutchinson area. Students also gained valuable insight into post-secondary options and future career decision-making.
- April 22, 2025: All 2nd-grade students from Hutchinson and GSL attended a field trip to the Science Museum of Minnesota. Students explored the museum's interactive exhibits and attended a showing of *Blue Whales* at the Omnitheater, enriching their learning in science and environmental studies.
