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PAYMENT PROCEDURES: Money may be deposited into student accounts with cash, check, online at www.schoolcafe.com OR through the School Cafe App STUDENT CHARGES (BORROWING/GRACE PERIOD): Students may charge <u>meals</u> up to the value of two breakfasts and two lunches (\$10.50 for High School). An automated phone call occurs when a negative balance appears on a student's account. If a student account exhausts the grace period/charge limit, the student must select a peanut butter and jelly or toasted cheese sandwich entrée for lunch and/or a cereal entrée for breakfast until the negative balance is paid. A la Carte / snack items are <u>not</u> available for charging. FREE/REDUCED-PRICE MEAL PROGRAM: We encourage you to complete the USDA free/reduced price meal application if you feel economic hardship exists. Applications expire each year and must be submitted each year. Applications can be submitted online at www.schoolcafe.com or through the SchoolCafe app on your mobile device to determine if you qualify for benefits. Hardcopy applications may be found at the school's front office, if needed, or at the Child Nutrition office located at 1110 Baker Dr. Tomball, TX 77375. Eligibility decisions are based on federally established income and household size guidelines without regard to race, sex, color, national origin, age, or disability.
