Crisis Response Services

- Suicide & Crisis Lifeline: Call 988
- Crisis Connections Team (DCCCT): Call 1-855-889-7827 for 24/7 in-person crisis intervention and follow-up support for all Delaware County residents. This includes de-escalation of crisis situations and creating a plan for a path forward

Behavioral Health Referral Services

Child & Adolescent Counseling with Psychiatric Services

- Lower Merion Counseling and Mobile Services: Call 484-383-0038 to connect with behavioral health supports, including medication management, staff includes psychiatrists, clinical social workers, psychologists, family therapists, and other mental health professionals. accepts most insurance
- Building Bridges: Call 610-566-4011 or book online for individual, family and group counseling services or psychiatric services insurance may reimburse at out-of-network rates
- <u>Thriveworks:</u> Call (855) 604-9873 for child/teen individual therapy, teletherapy or medication/psychiatry services. accepts most insurance



Systems of Care

"System of Care" in Delaware County refers to the guiding approach used by the Department of Human Services and its partners to coordinate services and supports for children, youth, and families with behavioral health needs. Most components are funded through Medical Assistance.

- <u>Community Care Behavioral Health Organization (CCBH):</u> Call 1-833-577-2682 to understand how to get connected to or access medical assistance for a continuum of behavioral health programs under the systems of care model. CCBH is the managed care organization for Delaware County that partners with providers (linked below) to coordinate benefits and ensure members can access necessary treatment
