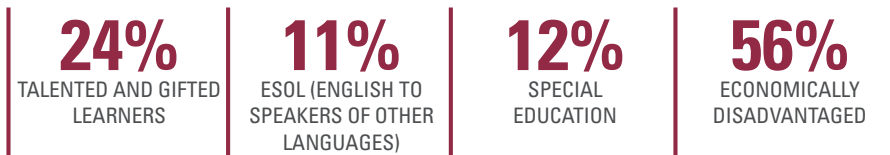
Student Population Forecast

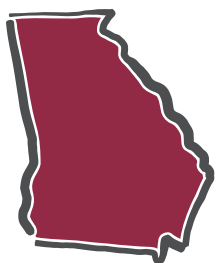
