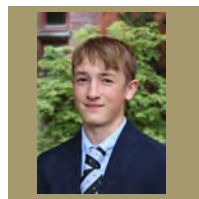


Thomas Lamerton

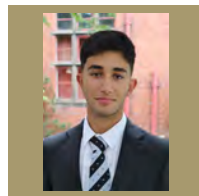


Shinil Balakrishnan

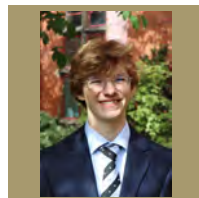


Joshua Norris

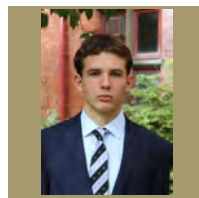


Alberto Rescigno

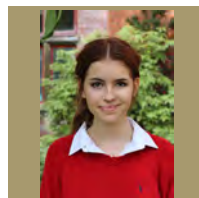


Bonnie Gardner-Mctaggart

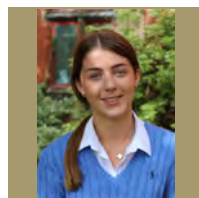


Isobel Gray

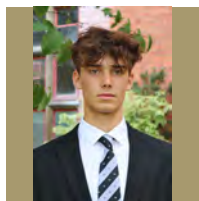
International Baccalaureate (IB)

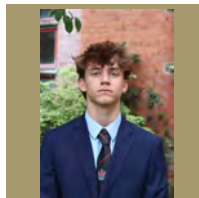


James Gannicott

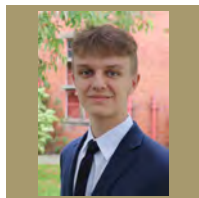


Dariusz Golabek

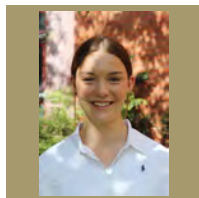


Cosima Beuer

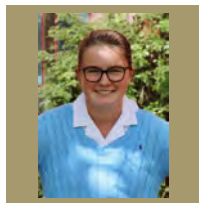

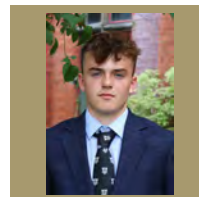


George Owen

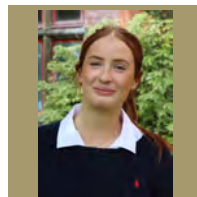
Anna Farr

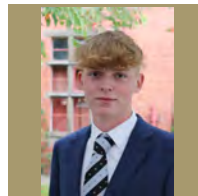


Charlie Boys
