A Home-School Learning Compact is a written agreement between the school, parents and students which defines each of our responsibilities and the actions we will take to help our children succeed at school. Compacts are required for schools receiving Title IA funds.



District/School/Teacher: The Gateway Regional School District's elementary schools are committed to helping your child reach their potential by:

- ★ Providing a safe, positive and healthy learning environment
- ★ Creating an environment of inclusion by fostering emotional and social growth
- ★ Teach necessary concepts and grade level curriculum to your child.
- ★ Be aware of and support the needs of your child.
- ★ Help your child follow school and classroom rules through modeling and practice.
- ★ Regularly communicate with you on your child's progress.

Caregiver: I realize that my child's school years are very important. I also understand that my participation in my child's education will help his/her achievement and attitude. Therefore, I agree to carry out the following responsibilities to the best of my ability:

- ★ Give my child a quiet place to study.
- ★ Encourage my child to complete his/her homework and check that it is done.
- ★ Make sure my child is at school and arrives on time.
- ★ Make sure my child reads on a daily basis.
- ★ Attend school and classroom functions and parent conferences
- ★ Volunteer my time to assist with school or classroom activities to the best of my ability.



Student: I know my education is important to me. It will help me become a better person. I know my family/guardians want to help me, but I am the one who has to do the work. Therefore, I agree to do the following:

- ★ Return completed classwork and homework on time.
- ★ Be at school on time unless I am sick.
- ★ Take responsibility for my own behavior.
- ★ Read on a daily basis.
- ★ Follow school and classroom rules.
