What is Title I ?

Title I are Federal Funds that are expected to:

- Strengthen the core program in schools and provide academic and/or academically-related support services to students.
- Provide evidence-based programs that enable participating students to achieve the learning standards of the state curriculum frameworks.

What is a Schoolwide Program?

- Title I funds are used, in combination with state and local resources, to upgrade the entire educational program of Gateway's three schools in order to raise the academic achievement of all students.
- Families, staff and administrators are involved in the planning, implementation, and evaluation process.

How will Title I funds be used at Gateway RSD?

Title I funds will be used to provide supplemental staffing to support student achievement and supplemental resources to support systems for academic growth. Funds also support communication and engagement of families to enhance family/guardian involvement in each student's education.

What are the primary objectives for our School's Title I program?

- To improve student achievement for all students
- To improve staff development
- To improve family and community involvement



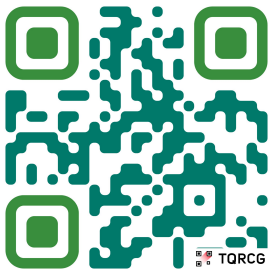
How will our district attain Title I objectives?

How are families and guardians notified?

- Families and Guardians have the right to request information about the qualification of the students teacher and instructional aides.
- Families and Guardians will be notified by letter if their child is taught for at least four consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not “highly qualified”
- Families will receive a survey link to provide feedback to the district.
