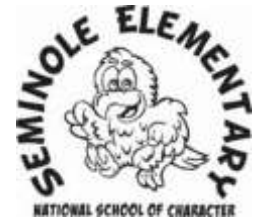

The dinner will be followed by a Curriculum Night for all grade levels. Teachers will share important curriculum information with families and tips on how to assist your child's learning at home. We hope to see many of our Seminole friends and families on October 8!

The first day of Enrichment Clusters is coming soon! Enrichment Clusters are a time for your child to meet with other students and adults (staff and volunteers) who share an interest in a topic and want to learn more about it. Topics range from Hand Talk (sign language) to CSI (forensics) to Spin, Twirl, Dance (flag color guard). There are 27 clusters that will meet each Wednesday from 1:30 to 2:30 beginning October 16 for ten weeks. Clusters are mixed grade levels; what students have in common is an interest in the topic. Students choose 3 clusters in which they are interested from the 27 offered. They will be placed in one of those three clusters. The big reveal on cluster participants is coming soon! Clusters will meet briefly on October 2 for students to get to know each other.
