Director - Heather Lundahl

Heather Lundahl began her music education in Monroe, New York where she studied flute with Kathleen Affigne, Ron Naroff and Beatrice Keram and performed in band under the baton of Dr. John Lynch. She went on to earn her Bachelor's of Music Education and Performer's Certificate from Indiana University, Bloomington where she performed in multiple ensembles including principal flute in the top Wind Ensemble and Orchestra. While at IU, she studied flute with Jacques Zoon and Thomas Robertello and conducting with Ray Cramer and Stephen Pratt. Her career as a middle school band director began at Mabry Middle School in Marietta, Georgia and continued at Shorewood Intermediate School in Milwaukee Wisconsin before moving to Florida. In 2002, she developed the vision for the band program at Blake Academy in Lakeland, where she taught students in grades three through eight. She began teaching middle school band and orchestra in Hillsborough County in 2010 and is currently in her 7th year as Director of Bands at Walker Middle Magnet International Baccalaureate World School. Mrs. Lundahl's bands and orchestras have consistently received superior ratings throughout her 15 years of teaching. Her memberships and professional affiliations include National Association for Music Education, Florida Music Educators Association and the Florida Bandmasters Association.

Director - Ted Shistle

Ted Shistle is in his fifth year as Director of Bands at Douglas Anderson School of the Arts (DA) and his 16th year as a music educator. His duties at DA include coordinating the band program, directing the Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, and Chamber Winds, and teaching AP Music Theory. Additionally at DA Mr. Shistle has conducted the annual musical (including an appearance at the Florida State Thespian Festival), the jazz band, and often guest conducts with the DA Symphony Orchestra. Mr. Shistle is active as an adjudicator throughout the state of Florida and makes frequent appearances conducting honor bands including the 3rd FBA Nine-Star Honor Band, and Flagler, Lee, and Polk County Honor Bands. Of all his professional achievements, Mr. Shistle is most proud of his students that have continued to study music and music education, and also those that have continued to find ways to stay involved with music in some way either in campus bands, community bands, or as educated consumers and supporters of art music in their communities.

Director - Dr. John Stanley Ross

Dr. John Stanley Ross is Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Music at Appalachian State University where he conducts the Appalachian Wind Ensemble, the Appalachian Concert Band, frequently guest conducts the Appalachian Symphonic Band, teaches courses in wind literature and band techniques, and guides all aspects of the ASU BANDS program. Dr. Ross serves as President of the Board of Directors of the New York City based WEAVE Soundpainting Orchestra, a professional interdisciplinary ensemble that features improvisation with musicians, dancers, visual artists, and actors. John Ross has commissioned and arranged several works for winds and has conducted twenty-four world premieres. In 2002, he completed his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Wind Conducting at Michigan State University where he instructed the graduate wind conducting seminar, taught private lessons in conducting and clarinet, supervised student teachers, and conducted the University Concert Band.
