

• **Keely Werly (Strings)** Mrs. Werly started her passion for music at a very early age with piano at eight years old, and cello by the time she was ten years old. As an adult, she decided to pursue a career in music by attending Bowling Green State University where she received a B.A. in Music Education. During the summer of 2008 she moved to Lakeland, FL to take an orchestral position with Polk County Schools. She began her career as a professional string educator teaching 4th-12th grade strings and orchestra. Her passion to teach inspired her own continuance of music education by earning a master’s degree from Boston University while still teaching full time. In 2015, Keely furthered her career by teaching middle school orchestra and guitar in Pinellas County. Her accomplishments include her own private studio in Pinellas County where her students learn the fundamentals, theory of music and playing with musicality and artistry. Mrs. Werly’s private students have placed in Florida’s All State Orchestra, Polk’s and Pinellas’ All County Orchestras, Lake Wale’s Solo Competition, and placements in area Performing Arts Schools. When Mrs. Werly is not teaching, she is regularly adjudicating Solo and Ensemble Festivals within the state of Florida, working with area string programs, and performing with various ensembles, such as Dade City Symphony and Tampa Bay Symphony..

• **Holly Mullenix (Orff)** Ms. Mullenix discovered a passion for education that led her to become a nationally recognized music educator. She went on to study this love and earned the following degrees: Bachelor of Science in Music Education, Ball State University; Master of Science in Music Technology, Indiana University; and Certification in Orff-Schulwerk, Anderson University. Ms. Mullenix has taught in an array of environments that span all the way to the graduate level. Holly’s numerous achievements include: Teacher of the Year, Hamilton Southeastern School District; Teacher of the Year, Curlew Creek Elementary; and the Teaching Excellence Award, Indiana School of Music at Indianapolis. Most notably, in 2009, Ms. Mullenix was bestowed the honorable Mr. Holland’s Opus Foundation National Award at Carnegie Hall. Currently, she is both President of the Greater Tampa Bay Area Orff Chapter and the North County Representative for Pinellas County Music Educators. While Ms. Mullenix continues to cultivate the learning experiences of her students, she remains a true advocate to one of her favorite mottos: “Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood.” Throughout the years, Holly Mullenix has dedicated her life not only to teaching music, but also to inspiring our youth to be their best creative, authentic, unique selves.

• **Kyle Goyens (Chorus)** Mr. Goyens is currently at the Choral Director at Ben Hill Middle School in Tampa, FL. He is a proud graduate of the University of South Florida in Tampa, FL with a B.S. in Music Education and a certification in K-12 Music. Prior to teaching at Ben Hill, Mr. Goyens taught for 4 years at Orange Grove Middle Magnet School of the Arts where he started the choral program and built it to over 150 students with over 5 different choirs who received superior and excellent ratings at District Festival! During his time at Ben Hill, Mr. Goyens started the program and built it up to over 130 students in the first year, and both Men’s Chorus and Women’s Chorus received superior ratings at the District 7 Choral Music Performance Assessment in their inaugural year as a choral department. Mr. Goyens’s students are well represented in State and County Honor Choirs and he is also a proud and active member of FMEA, NAFME, FVA, American Choral Directors Association, Phi Mu Alpha and Sigma Phi Epsilon. The Orange Grove Music Department received the FMEA Enrollment Award in 2012, 2015 and the Ben Hill Music Department also received this award in 2016.

• **Kristin Hecht (Drumming)** Ms. Hecht has been a leader in music education in Pinellas County and the State of Florida for 14 years; facilitating numerous trainings and workshops in the areas of Percussion, Elementary Music Methodology, Best Practices, Music Education & Innovation, and Music Technology. Ms. Hecht’s vision has always been to provide each student with the highest quality music instruction with a “Commitment to Excellence”. Her students develop core character values, integrity, a solid work ethic, and learn to build positive work habits through music. Through music, Ms. Hecht helps students to build self-esteem and a foundation for a successful future. Many of Ms. Hecht’s students have gone on to study music at the collegiate level and gain employment in Music Education or the Performing Arts. Ms. Hecht enjoys a busy schedule as a percussion instructor for students in the Tarpon Springs High School Leadership Conservatory for the Arts and as a clinician, composer and arranger for High School Percussion Ensembles. Ms. Hecht is currently the Music Specialist at Oldsmar Elementary where she teaches General Music as well as several vocal and instrumental ensembles to over 600 students. Ms. Hecht is the Oldsmar Elementary Teacher of the Year for 2015, and a proud alumnus of Tarpon Springs and the University of South Florida.
