Lancer Families:

Thank you for selecting to tryout for one of our Lancer teams! This letter is to inform you of some basic information regarding our Middle School Athletic Program.

Pinellas County Schools Middle School Athletics Program does not provide busing or transportation for athletic teams. Therefore, if your child is interested in participating by being on one of our teams, it means their families are agreeing to transport them to and from away games and picking up promptly after home games and practices. Typically, games begin between 4:45pm and 5pm. Students need picked up usually around 6:15pm. Our coaches will have a vehicle information sheet with their insurance and license information on file, should they ever need to transport a student athlete, however they should be used sparingly for transportation. If you need a coach to transport your student athlete to a game, you need to communicate this prior to the game. Please make arrangements early!

Communication about practices and games will be provided to the athlete and will be posted on the school website as well as the district athletic website.

Uniforms are supplied by the school to use for the season. Uniforms must be returned at the close of the season. If the uniform is not returned your student will be charged the replacement value which varies based on the sport you play. You will be invoiced for lost or damaged uniforms and it will be attached to your student's FOCUS account.

Additionally, the district does charge admission for spectators. Games are \$3 per person, and it is GoFan electronic ticketing ONLY. You can find the site link for GoFan on our website.

The packet enclosed includes the requirements for trying out for any of our athletic teams. Please note that ALL paperwork must be turned in prior to trying out, **NO EXCEPTIONS!** We DO NOT offer late tryouts due to not having documentation. Physicals can be hard to get on short notice, so make appointments early. Thank you for your interest in the athletic program at Meadowlawn Middle School and please let me know if you have any questions or concerns.
