The West Seneca Community is centrally located in Western New York. West Seneca is southeast of Buffalo and is a “first ring” suburb of that city. It is the third largest suburban school district in Western New York and is comprised of five elementary buildings, two middle school buildings, and two high schools. The district employs approximately 1200 employees, which includes teachers, administrators and support staff.

In conjunction with regular instruction, the West Seneca CSD provides a Continuing Education Program. Occupational and vocational programs are offered to West Seneca CSD students through participation with Erie 1 BOCES.

A comprehensive special education program provides a full continuum of services. Students with disabilities are provided education within our district schools with attention to seamless, least-restrictive settings. West Seneca participates in collaborative agreements with area social services agencies to enhance support for our special needs students and their families.
