Calculation of GPA

A student’s cumulative GPA is computed at the end of each semester. All grades 9-12 courses are used in the calculation except for college classes not taught by a Northern Lehigh faculty member. College, AP, and Honors courses are weighted. The GPA for each individual course is determined by converting the final numerical average (0% to 100%) to its 4 – Point Equivalent according to the following conversion scale. In calculating GPA weighted courses are awarded 1 additional quality point, i.e. an A in an honors class will be calculated using a 5 instead of a 4.

Each individual course GPA is then averaged with the GPA of all other courses taken during the school year to determine the overall GPA for that school year. A cumulative GPA encompasses all course work completed up to that point in the student’s high school education.

Class Rank

Class rank is based upon the student’s cumulative GPA. The number one ranked student will be the student with the highest GPA, number two the second highest, etc.

Grading Policy:

Grade Determination Formula (Final Average):

***Semester Courses with Exams**

Each teacher assigns a numerical average to the two marking periods and the final exam per semester. Each marking period is 45% and the final exam is 10% of the final grade.
