

OPENING UP THE WORLD

ALUM HONORS MR. BUD PAAPE'S LEGACY THROUGH A LASTING SCHOLARSHIP

Over four decades (1968–1987, 1989–1999), beloved teacher Mr. Bud Paape challenged Totino-Grace students to expand their worldviews, deepen their understanding of global affairs, and appreciate diverse cultures and perspectives. Known for his high expectations and rigorous grading, Mr. Paape was more than an English and writing teacher—he was a mentor who helped students find their voices and connect with the world around them.

As moderator of the school newspaper, he guided students in thoughtful storytelling and critical analysis. But it was his classroom—lined with *Time* Magazine covers and buzzing with debate—that many remember most vividly. His former students recall lively discussions on current events, world politics, and social injustices—topics that Mr. Paape didn't just teach, but lived.

Throughout his career, Paape took two leaves to serve in the Peace Corps, teaching English abroad. He was fluent in four languages—English, French, Igbo, and Spanish—and brought to the classroom a depth of knowledge and global perspective few could match. Students often said he “opened up the world” for them, encouraging critical thinking and cultivating empathy in the process.

One such student was **Michael Wethington '75**, who vividly remembers the impact Mr. Paape had on his life.

“Classroom discussions were centered around current events, world politics, and social injustices,” Wethington recalls. “Paape would often learn our opinion on a topic and then purposely assign us the opposing viewpoint to debate. He was a genius at developing world-thinkers, and I’ve drawn from that throughout my life and career. Now, as I reflect on my journey, I see what I know Paape would agree with—that learning is the key to connecting us all.”

Michael Wethington went on to have a distinguished 40-year career building profitable, high-growth businesses across a wide range of industries—from start-ups to multinational corporations. His achievements include the development and sale of four leading-edge technology companies, delivering over \$1 billion in value and significant returns for shareholders. And yet, through all his success, he never forgot the teacher who helped shape his global outlook and inspired his lifelong pursuit of knowledge and connection.

In honor of Mr. Paape's extraordinary influence, Michael and his wife, Wendy, have established the **Bud Paape Memorial Scholarship**—a tribute to the values and vision that Paape lived and taught. The scholarship supports students who demonstrate curiosity, empathy, volunteerism, or a distinct interest in different races and cultures—hallmarks of Paape's teaching philosophy.

Recognizing that countless Eagles were influenced by Mr. Paape during his decades at Totino-Grace, Wethington extended an invitation to fellow alumni to join in honoring this legacy. He pledged a **\$100,000 match** toward all

gifts made in Mr. Paape's name—and the response was inspiring. This summer, 52 alumni took Wethington up on his match incentive, and thanks to their generosity, the Bud Paape Memorial Scholarship was awarded to two incoming freshmen this school year.

Endowed by Michael and Wendy Wethington, the scholarship will be awarded in perpetuity, ensuring Mr. Paape's legacy continues to inspire Totino-Grace students for generations to come. All are welcome to join in honoring Mr. Paape, with the matching opportunity available through 2025—doubling the impact of every gift.



LEGACY OF EXCELLENCE:

THE MILLER FAMILY'S DEEP ROOTS AT TOTINO-GRACE

After 23 years of dedicated service to the Totino-Grace community, Pam Miller is preparing to close one chapter of her life while opening another. As she looks toward retirement this fall, her legacy extends far beyond her work in the TG Business Office; it lives on through three sons who exemplify the very best of what TG can nurture in its students.

A Foundation Built on Community

Pam's journey at Totino-Grace began over two decades ago when she joined the Business Office team. Throughout her tenure, she has worn many hats: helping families navigate tuition responsibilities, managing vendor relationships, and contributing to signature events like the TG Gala and Eagle Shoot. But ask

Pam about her favorite memories, and she doesn't mention spreadsheets or financial processes – she talks about the students.

"My favorite memories, hands down, all involve time spent with our students in a variety of capacities and the energy and enthusiasm I've received from being with them," Pam reflected. "My greatest hope is that I have touched each of their hearts as much as they've made an imprint on mine."

This philosophy of putting relationships first didn't just shape Pam's professional approach, it became the cornerstone of her family's experience at TG. Her three sons, Brandon '06, Bryant '08, and Cameron '13, each discovered their own paths while sharing common threads that trace back to their TG foundation.

Brandon Miller '06

Brandon Miller's story began on the soccer fields of Totino-Grace, where he would eventually be voted "Mr. Soccer" and win state titles (2002 and 2004) which helped develop skills that would serve him far beyond athletics. After graduating in 2006, he took his talents to UW-Madison, playing soccer while earning an Agricultural Business Management degree. Today, he works as a Sales Engineer for Dell Technologies, living in Minnetonka with his wife Molly and their two children, Mason and Addison.

"Everything in life I have done since high school has centered around relationships," Brandon explained, "and TG taught me how to build strong relationships at a key stage in my development." Those



relationships weren't just with peers, they were with mentors who left lasting impressions. Brandon particularly remembers Bill and Chris Vance, who "led by example in how committed they were to their faith and how passionate they were for TG both in the classroom and on the soccer field."

The lessons learned from coaches like Chris Beach, who would run endless laps to check in with every subset of the track team, and teachers like Ned Thompson, who "managed to weave in life lessons as he taught the curriculum," became pillars of Brandon's foundation as he moved into college and the corporate world.

Bryant Miller '08

Two years behind his brother, Bryant Miller charted his own course while drawing from the same TG well. After graduating in 2008, he headed to UW-Madison for Journalism and Strategic Communication, then embarked on a career journey that took him from Los Angeles to Chicago to Minneapolis and finally to Washington, D.C., where he now leads a marketing team at Nestlé USA's headquarters in Arlington.

Bryant's reflection on his TG experience reveals the depth of impact the school had on his character development. "Totino-Grace helped instill in me a strong work ethic balanced with an equal and deep caring for others," he said. "During college and throughout my experience in the business world, I've consistently leveraged this mentality to push for strong results in a way that also prioritizes others."

Like his brother, Bryant found inspiration in TG's educators. Ms. Carroll taught him "how to think (a stark difference from what to think)," while Mr. Beach instilled in him the importance of "only accepting

exceptional standards and results, both on and off the track." But perhaps most significantly, Bryant emphasizes the transformative power of service, encouraging current students to get involved in campus ministry or mission trips, noting that "they have a big impact on the person you become later in life."

Cameron Miller '13

The youngest of the Miller brothers, Cameron graduated in 2013 and chose a path of service that reflects TG's emphasis on caring for others. After earning a Criminal Justice degree with a Psychology minor from St. Cloud State University, he now serves as a full-time police officer at MSP International Airport while working part-time as a firefighter and EMT.

Cameron's memories of TG center on the excitement of competition – "playing a home soccer game under the lights and the 400-meter relay race at the end of True Team State for Track" – but his gratitude extends to the people who shaped his experience. Like his brothers, he was influenced by the Vance brothers, whose "passion for soccer showed every day on and off the field and brushed off on more students/players than they will ever know."

He also remembers Andrew Blake's enthusiastic coaching style and Mike Shimek's unique classroom approach, including his famous circular seating arrangement that kept everyone engaged. These experiences helped Cameron "grow exponentially as a young adult in preparation to attend college, and live on my own."

Common Threads, Individual Paths

While each Miller brother found his own way, certain themes emerge consistently in their reflections. All three credit TG with teaching them

the importance of relationships, hard work, and service to others. They share appreciation for educators who challenged them and they all emphasize current students should embrace every opportunity.

"TG has an amazing staff, a great support system and a foundation rooted in faith and community," Brandon advises current students. "Take advantage of every opportunity around you to form lasting relationships and prepare yourself for success in whichever path you choose!"

Bryant echoes this sentiment, "You're fortunate to have a wealth of resources and supporters who want to see you succeed – something that becomes even clearer when talking with new friends post-high school (not everyone has these!)."

Cameron's advice is beautifully simple, "Enjoy the experience while it is here. Looking back 12 years later, it definitely went by fast. Have fun!"

A New Chapter Begins

As Pam approaches retirement, her bucket list reflects the values that shaped her family's TG experience: relationships, adventure, and service. She looks forward to spending time with her children and grandchildren, traveling with her husband, continuing charitable work, and staying active with biking, walking, golf, Pilates, and pickleball. Her message to TG parents, "Get involved right away! It's a wonderful way to meet other families and discover just how amazing this community is."

The Miller family serves as a living testimony to what can happen at TG. They may be saying goodbye to one chapter of their TG story, but their legacy, like the relationships and values they've cultivated, will endure for generations to come.



SHE LEAVES IT ALL ON THE FIELD

CLAIRE (AZMAN) GROH '06

From her days as a varsity soccer player at Totino-Grace, to her career in medical services, Claire Groh represents deep commitment and an unmatched work ethic towards the things she's passionate about. Luckily for TG, one of those passions is still the Totino-Grace Girls Varsity Soccer team. Claire has spent the last fourteen years on the sidelines bringing an energy and an Eagle pride that stems from playing and coaching for the

Eagles for the majority of two decades. Coaching for TG has been both a joy and sacrifice, as she travels from Eagan to make the commitment work. When asked why she doesn't just find a team to coach closer to home she was quick to reply, "For me, it's about *the Eagles* and it will always be about *the Eagles*. I'm not interested in coaching anywhere else. Or with anyone else."

Claire and head coach, Matt Thibodeau, have been a dynamic duo for all of Claire's fourteen years on staff. "We've built a bond, a trust, and an understanding of our goals and purpose with this program. That takes a long time to build, and I'm proud of the program and results we have built together." Coach Thibodeau shared, "It's her passion that is so outstanding; her love for the girls and the program are unmatched. It's really nice to share that passion with her. She was a spitfire of a player and the same as a coach. Over the last 14 years, 'gone in the blink of an eye', we have become really good friends as well. That doesn't always happen with a coaching staff, so I feel extremely lucky that I have had Claire and other fantastic coaches that have been able to make a positive difference for the girls."

When asked what has been her favorite coaching memory over the last fourteen years, Claire admitted that was a hard question, but ultimately chose beating Mahtomedi in 2023 in the section finals, as the "insane underdogs", scoring on only one of two shot attempts to win the game. The team went on to finish third in state that season.

Professionally, Claire graduated from University of Wisconsin-Madison, earning an economics degree, with a math emphasis. Her career started in financial services and soon switched to the healthcare industry. After five years as Chief of Staff at Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Minnesota, Claire transitioned to a regional nonprofit health plan, Medica, and is a Senior Director in Operations.

Beyond coaching, Claire enjoys traveling and spending time with her husband, Andy, and their two daughters. TG is grateful for Claire's commitment to Totino-Grace and the girls' soccer program.

Most companies have a mission statement, but at MissionBridge Wealth, their mentality is to be a mission, with a business. The idea of mission-work and service was not always central to Nick Bednarczyk '95. After graduating from Totino-Grace, Nick earned a business degree from the University of St. Thomas and started a career in financial planning. He started with the mindset that most of us do in life: work hard, move-up, and build the life you want. Following years of growing in and wisdom through lived industry experience, including hard lessons through multiple recessions, God challenged him to help people at a higher level and to live for His will. Nick leaned into personal development work and his faith, which among other life changes, led to taking a leap in leaving an established practice in order to launch Mission-Bridge Wealth, where the focus is on helping people live their life of most significance. Each interaction is an opportunity to "provide value and leave a positive impression."

Nick believes God has placed the right people in his path at the right time to help grow the impact. One of the key individuals is fellow TG grad, Matt Bosway '96.

After attending St. Thomas alongside Bednarczyk as a Finance grad (and compiling a roster of stories not to be shared in this feature)

Bosway set course on building a 20-year career with 3M, where he became well-versed in Global Business. This took Matt as far as Japan, and ultimately relocated his life in Austin, TX, where he eventually transitioned away from the corporate world into small business as President of a commercial landscaping company. In the same season of life, having two children with a third on the way, he felt a pull to come back home to Minnesota. Little did he know that a relationship that went separate ways years ago, and his personal desire to go back into the financial industry, would result in what he views as "the perfect fit" in joining the MissionBridge Wealth team.

Today, both Matt and Nick find ways to give back through speaking at TG career fairs, financially supporting the mission at TG, and as brand ambassadors. Nick's advice for today's Eagles comes from a financial principle of the "compound effect." He says, "Your decisions will have a compound effect - good decisions will work for you and bad decisions will work against you. Manage your decisions so they don't manage you." He adds, "Surrounding yourself with good people will impact your decision-making and work in your favor."



THE FIRST EAGLES - STILL SOARING

As the very first graduating class of Grace High School, the Class of 1970 has always held a special place in our school's history—and in 2025, they made history once again. For the first time, an entire class came together to create an **endowed scholarship** that will live on in perpetuity, providing renewable financial aid to Totino-Grace students for generations to come. In anticipation of their 55th reunion, lifelong friends and classmates Michael Heiges, Elizabeth (Liza) Cutter, and Diane Kozlak found themselves wondering how their alma mater had evolved over the years. They organized a "Conversation with the President," inviting fellow classmates back to campus for a tour and Q&A with President Dr. Craig Junker. What they discovered

inspired them deeply: the same strong Catholic values they experienced as students remain vibrant today—now in an even more diverse, dynamic school community. Moved by the mission and the growing need for tuition assistance, the Class of 1970, led by this dedicated trio, launched a fundraising effort to establish a legacy of support for future Eagles. With contributions from 21 classmates and former faculty members, the **Class of 1970 Endowed Scholarship** was born. Fittingly, the scholarship is awarded to students who, like the trailblazing Class of 1970, are the first in their families to attend Totino-Grace and have shown a willingness to step outside their comfort zone and try something new just as the Class of 1970 did.

We caught up with this remarkable Eagle trio—lifelong friends who still vacation together (most recently in New Zealand!)—to learn more about their journeys since graduating as the very first Eagles of Grace High School and how their enduring bond inspired a lasting legacy at Totino-Grace.



MICHAEL HEIGES '70

After graduating from St. Mary's, Michael Heiges returned to his alma mater to teach in the religion department at Grace for five years. He planned to stay longer but relocated his family to Chicago when his wife pursued optometry school. In Chicago, Heiges transitioned into a sales career and, after six years, co-founded Marketing Frontiers with two partners in 1987. ELIZABETH CUTTER '70



FAITH FORMATION THROUGH TOTINO-GRACE CO-CURRICULARS

At Totino-Grace, faith formation is not confined to theology classes, the Campus Ministry Office, or moments of quiet reflection in our chapel—it permeates every corner of student life. From the athletic fields to the stage, and in every club meeting and creative endeavor, our co-curricular programs are intentionally designed as opportunities for students to live out their faith through the activities they are most passionate about.

With the support of school leadership, the Activities Office, and Campus Ministry, every Totino-Grace team, club, and activity now develops an annual faith formation plan. Created collaboratively by coaches, moderators, directors, and student leaders, these plans reflect the unique identity and values of each group. While each approach is different, they all share a common purpose: to root practices, performances, and competitions in prayer, engage in meaningful service, and cultivate intentional, faith-filled relationships.

The results are powerful and deeply authentic. Boys hockey teams invite their opponents to pray together on the ice. The baseball team makes time to serve during their spring break travel. Girls basketball begins their season

with a team Mass. A boys soccer student-leader leads his teammates in a prayer of gratitude on the way to U.S. Bank Stadium for the State Tournament. Even our music department integrates faith and service into every trip, turning performances into mission experiences.

This year, a group of seniors has taken this initiative even further. Inspired by the Lasallian call to lead with faith and integrity, they launched the Fellowship of Lasallian Athletes—a student-led faith-sharing group for those involved in sports and activities. Meeting monthly, they reflect on Scripture, share personal experiences, set goals, and encourage one another to live their faith boldly in competitive and creative spaces. Rooted in prayer and community, this group exemplifies the spirit of servant leadership.

As we look ahead, we're inspired by the creativity, commitment, and faith of our student leaders, coaches, and moderators. Their efforts ensure that every practice, performance, game, and gathering is not just about achievement—but about growing closer to God, to one another, and to the Lasallian mission that guides us all.



TOTINO-GRACE SERVICE & IMMERSION TRIPS

NEW YORK CITY 2025

In April, seven Totino-Grace seniors embarked on a transformative Service & Immersion experience in New York City, rooted in our Catholic, Lasallian mission. The group stayed with the Dominican Sisters and was graciously hosted by the Christian Brothers of Bedford Park in the Bronx. Each day, students served at **Part of the Solution (POTS)**, a nonprofit dedicated to supporting individuals and families facing the realities of urban poverty. POTS provides holistic services—including job training, housing assistance, mental health support, and basic needs such as meals and showers.

Our students primarily contributed to POTS' hunger relief efforts, preparing, serving, and cleaning up daily lunches for over 150 guests and assisting in the food pantry. There, they guided families in selecting nutritious groceries, restocked shelves, and ensured guests felt seen and supported. The experience offered powerful lessons in dignity, solidarity, and compassion.

Beyond service, the group engaged in prayer, meals, and reflection with the Christian Brothers and fellow Lasallians—exploring the depth of intentional community and faith in action. The week also included cultural and spiritual enrichment: visits to the 9/11 Memorial & Museum, Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral, and guided exploration of the city with a variety of hosts—including former TG teacher, Mrs.



Fagan. The experience left a lasting impression, inspiring students to carry forward the values of justice, faith, and service in their everyday lives.

GUATEMALA 2025

During the final week of school, ten Totino-Grace juniors and seniors, accompanied by Principal Cheri Broadhead and Vice President for Advancement Shannon Hartinger, traveled to Antigua, Guatemala, for an international Service & Immersion trip. In partnership with **Common Hope**, a Minnesota-based nonprofit that works alongside Guatemalan families to improve lives through education, healthcare, housing, and family development, students engaged in meaningful service and cultural exchange. The group's primary mission was to build a home for a family in need—a structure with a concrete floor, secure roof, and windows,

offering stability, dignity, and ownership. Students participated in every phase of construction, gaining both practical skills and life-changing perspective. Beyond the build, the immersion experience included wellness visits to local homes, English language instruction in area schools, visits to churches, and hands-on learning about Guatemalan traditions such as backpack weaving, as well as tours of coffee and cocoa plantations. This transformative journey deepened students' understanding of global poverty, culture, and community—and strengthened their call to servant leadership.

Our students across the board were especially moved by the repeated call to action and the reminder that lasting change is found in communities of faith who serve together. Both trips were a powerful expression of the mission of our Lasallian Service & Immersion Program: to form young people who live as a *Community of Believers*, gathered in *Faith*, to *Serve* others.





SPRING SPORTS

BASEBALL

Totino-Grace baseball finished 22-8 and placed 3rd in the Northwest Suburban Conference. The Eagles earned the No. 1 seed in sections, battled back through the loser's bracket with five straight wins, including two over Princeton, to capture the section title and advance to state for the second straight year. At state, TG fell in the opener but defeated Simley and Grand Rapids to win the Consolation Championship.

BOYS GOLF

The boys golf team won sections by 38 strokes and went on to place 4th at state, just 12 shots behind the champion. All six golfers finished in the top 12 individually at sections, led by Collin Ramos '26 (1st), Drew Burstad '28 (2nd), and senior Vince Zurek '25 (3rd). Ramos and Ben Appelhof '26 earned All-State honors, while Ramos, Appelhof, Burstad, and Connor Cloud '27 were All-Conference.

GIRLS GOLF

The girls golf team went 6-1 in

conference play, won sections, and advanced to state for the first time since 1999, finishing tied for 3rd. Sam Young '25 and Katelyn Peterson '27 recorded personal bests, while Grace Raich '26 and Kaitlyn Burstad '25 were named All-State. Young, Raich, and Burstad also earned All-Conference recognition.

BOYS LACROSSE

A young TG boys lacrosse squad showed steady growth during the 2025 season, highlighted by an overtime win over Osseo/Park Center and a memorable road trip to Duluth. Blake Meyer '28 earned All-Conference. Looking ahead, the program welcomes back alumnus Justin Hoban '98, who previously coached TG from 2003-14.

GIRLS LACROSSE

The girls lacrosse team finished 5-9 while scoring 127 goals, with strong showings in rivalry games. With much of the roster returning, the Eagles are set to build on this momentum next season.

SOFTBALL

TG softball finished 9-15 and placed 4th in sections. Adri Cогнетта '27 and Caroline Pollard '25 earned All-Section honors, while Cогнетта, Pollard, and Maya Anderson '25 received All-Conference recognition.

BOYS TENNIS

The boys tennis team finished 4-13, with seven close 4-3 losses. Aidan Raddohl '26 earned All-Conference, while Bennett Bednarczyk '25, Sawyer Carlson '25, and Luke Brandt '26 received honorable mention. Bednarczyk and Connor Poitras '25 reached the Section 6A quarterfinals with an upset win over No. 5 seed Fridley.

TRACK & FIELD

TG track had a record-setting year. The boys team won their section for true team state. School records were set by Matt Lindgren '25

(1600m), Michael Strong '25 (110m and 300m hurdles), the 4x200m relay (Strong, Jaden Miller '26, Abishard Archille '25, Josiah Young '25), and the 4x400m relay (Strong, Lindgren, Vince Jacob '25, Young). At state, Young won the 400m, Strong placed 2nd in the 300m hurdles, and Lindgren finished 4th in the 1600m and 6th in the 800m. The 4x400m relay team captured the state title.

ACTIVITIES

E-SPORTS

Totino-Grace esports competed in Valorant, Smash Ultimate, Mario Kart, Fortnite Duos, Chess, and Rocket League during the 2024-25 season. Players in Smash Ultimate, Mario Kart, Chess, and Fortnite Duos qualified for state. TG finished top 8 in Mario Kart's inaugural state competition, and Jegan Joseph '25 placed in the top 10 of 143 players in Smash Ultimate. Since joining the league in 2021, TG has qualified for state every year.

FISHING

In its second official season, TG's fishing team fielded 30 anglers and 13 teams at local and state competitions. Two teams, Jayden Erickson '26/Alex Gagnon '26 and Gus Hay '26/Keegan Kiedrowski '26, qualified for the Tournament of Champions on Lake Pokegama, both finishing in the top half of the field.

ROBOTICS

TG Robotics welcomed seven freshmen to a roster of 18 students, supported by six mentors and one coach. After preseason projects, including equipment upgrades and training, the team built and coded a new robot in six weeks. They earned a safety award at their first competition and advanced to become a finals backup at St. Cloud,



recording their best finish since 2019.

LINK AMBASSADORS

The 2024-25 school year featured one of TG's most personable groups of LINK Ambassadors. Selected to guide freshmen and transfer students, ambassadors fostered a welcoming environment that exemplified TG's community and culture.

MATH TEAM

The math team placed 2nd in the AA division of the state tournament, TG's highest finish in program history. Entering seeded 9th, the Eagles scored 72 points to climb to 2nd and earn their first state medal. TG also received the "Quantum Leap" award for rising 13 places overall, from 31st to 18th among all divisions. This marked the program's 4th state appearance in five years.

MOCK TRIAL

TG mock trial students argued *Murder in the Boundary Waters* during the 2024-25 season, competing at the Red Knight Scrimmage, Minneapple Tournament, and regional trials at the Ramsey County Courthouse. The season concluded with visits to the State Capitol, the Minnesota Court of Appeals, and the Saint Paul Police Department crime lab for a hands-on look at the legal system.

TRAP SHOOTING

TG's spring trap shooting team included 47 athletes, 14 of them new. Three shooters, Quinton Harrer '27, Daniel Dobbelmann '28, and Hunter Lipa '29 recorded perfect 25s, with Harrer also hitting 50 straight. Six athletes earned All-Conference honors, all female: Ava Schlichting '28, Amanda Fabozzi '26, Lainie Houck '26, Azaleah Streeper '26, Donny Lockwood '26, and Sydney Keir '26. Thirteen athletes competed

in the championship tournament in Alexandria.

DECA

DECA had a standout year of growth and achievement. In October, 31 students participated in the Back to Business Conference. At the February district competition, TG earned 18 top-six finishes and 15 top-three placements, qualifying 26 students for state. Of the 21 who competed, three advanced to finals. Members also organized three fundraisers that supported competition costs and provided hands-on business experience.

ARTS

VOCAL MUSIC

In addition to show choir, TG's vocal music program features two curricular choirs, Chamber Singers, Tenor/Bass Ensemble, and Mass musicians.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

TG's instrumental music program includes four chamber groups, two jazz ensembles, the musical pit orchestra, show choir bands, and Mass musicians. The jazz ensembles performed a Christmas show, the annual *18th & Vine* Swing Dance, and closed the year with a concert at Crooners Jazz Club, one of the nation's top jazz venues.

Both vocal and instrumental groups are preparing for a 2026 performance tour of Peru.

SHOW CHOIR

Totino-Grace is one of the few schools in the nation to support three competitive show choirs:

Company of Singers (varsity), *Encore Singers* (all-female), and *T-Tones* (all-male). Each group earned at least one 1st-place finish during the season, with *Encore* taking "Best Prep Group" twice. *Company of Singers* capped the year with a grand championship in Spirit Lake, Iowa, their first in four years. The season concluded with TG's annual Show Choir Spectacular, which welcomed 19 groups from five states and more than 1,000 guests.

THEATER

Theater productions included the fall musical *Godspell*, the winter *Evening of 10-Minute Plays* in TG's Black Box format, and the spring children's musical, which welcomed hundreds of visiting elementary and middle school students. The *Godspell* cast enjoyed a special meal hosted by alumni from TG's 1983 production.

NEW CHOIR DIRECTOR

Ms. Tori Hornby joins TG as choir director in her sixth year of teaching. A South St. Paul native and Luther College graduate, she is pursuing a master's in music education at the University of St. Thomas. Previously a middle school choir teacher, she brings experience as both an educator and former varsity show choir performer.
