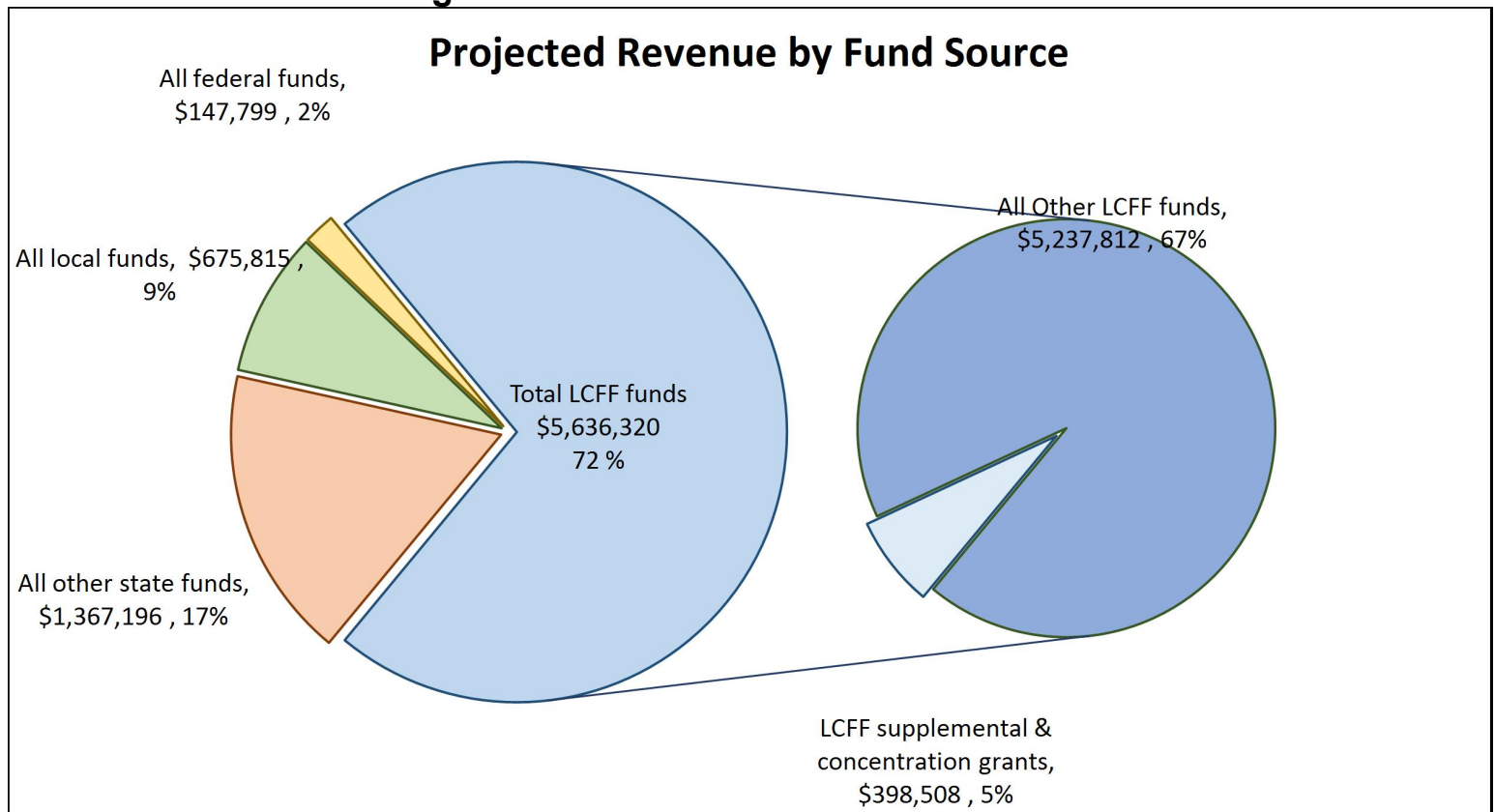

LCFF funds include a base level of funding for all LEAs and extra funding - called "supplemental and concentration" grants - to LEAs based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learners, and low-income students).

### Budget Overview for the 2025-26 School Year

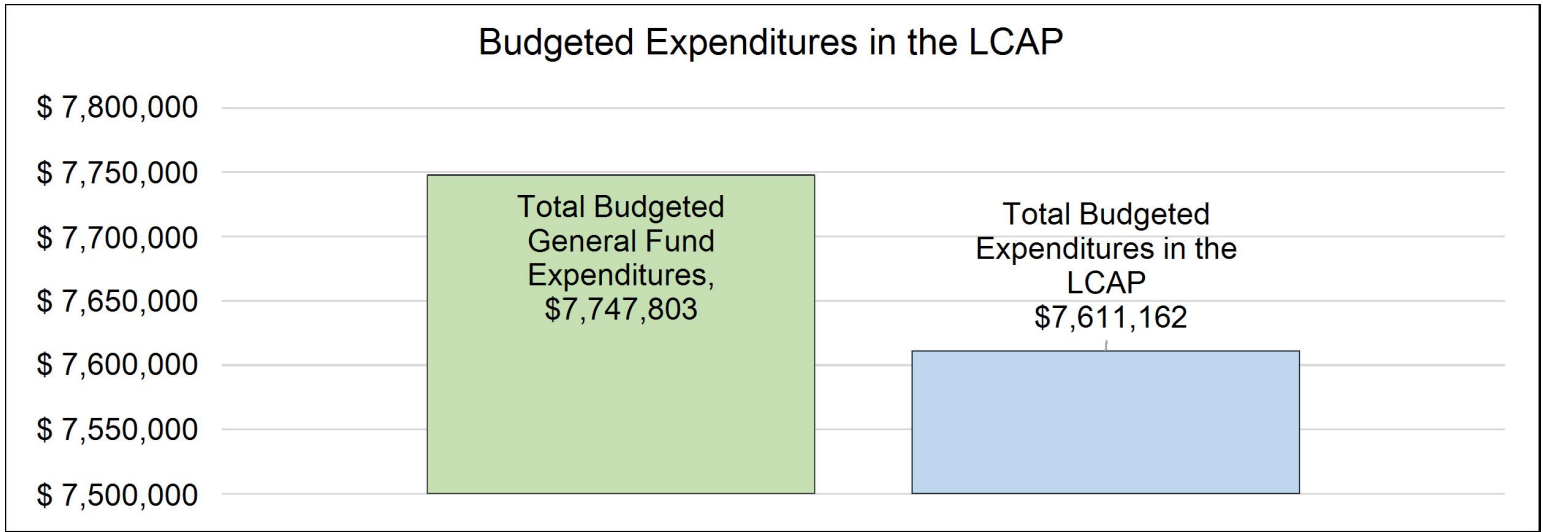


This chart shows the total general purpose revenue Nea Community Learning Center expects to receive in the coming year from all sources.

The text description for the above chart is as follows: The total revenue projected for Nea Community Learning Center is \$7,827,130, of which \$5,636,320.00 is Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), \$1,367,196.00 is other state funds, \$675,815.00 is local funds, and \$147,799.00 is federal funds. Of the \$5,636,320.00 in LCFF Funds, \$398,508.00 is generated based on the enrollment of high needs students (foster youth, English learner, and low-income students).

The LCFF gives school districts more flexibility in deciding how to use state funds. In exchange, school districts must work with parents, educators, students, and the community to develop a Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) that shows how they will use these funds to serve students.



This chart provides a quick summary of how much Nea Community Learning Center plans to spend for 2025-26. It shows how much of the total is tied to planned actions and services in the LCAP.

The text description of the above chart is as follows: Nea Community Learning Center plans to spend \$7,747,803.00 for the 2025-26 school year. Of that amount, \$7,611,162.00 is tied to actions/services in the LCAP and \$136,641 is not included in the LCAP. The budgeted expenditures that are not included in the LCAP will be used for the following:

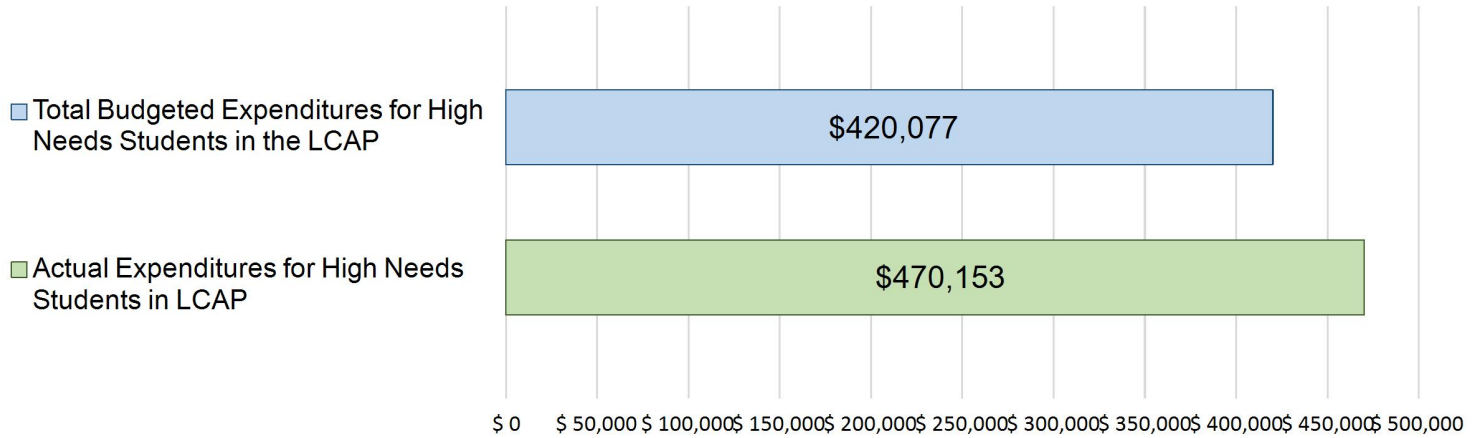
## Increased or Improved Services for High Needs Students in the LCAP for the 2025-26 School Year
