

IB Diploma Programme Overview – 2025/2026

FULL IB DIPLOMA TRACK REQUIREMENTS:

6 Courses (see course combinations below) + TOK + CAS + EE:

- TOK = **Theory of Knowledge** (students explore different types of knowledge and how it is acquired in this philosophical course, assessed with an exhibition and a 1,600 word essay)
- CAS = **Creativity, Activity, Service** (students engage in projects that strengthen their creativity, promote physical activity, and benefit their community)
- EE = **Extended Essay** (students conduct independent research project, which culminates in a 4,000 word essay)

COURSE COMBINATIONS :

Students have to choose ONE course in each of the following blocks: 3 HL – Higher Level subjects (240 hours per subject) and 3 SL – Standard Level subjects (150 hours per subject)

***NOTES on Block 1 & 2 choices:**

- English is obligatory for all students, as according to our *Language Policy*, students must have a B2 Level of English minimum.
- Students must select at least one A LL (Language & Literature) course to study at the native level.
- A bilingual diploma is awarded to candidates who complete and receive a grade 3 or higher in two A LL (Language & Literature) courses, for example, both English A LL and French A LL.
- Students may select one Language B course to study as a language acquisition course.
- Students who are beginners in French may choose to study French AB (initio) at the beginner level.
- Private Tutors need to be engaged for any Mother Tongue Self-Taught Language (STL) courses at an extra expense. Students enrolled in a STL class can choose French as their 7th subject.

Please be aware that all subject choices will be confirmed and registered after an individual meeting with each student/family with the IB DP coordinator and teachers.

All subject offers are provisional and a class needs to meet the minimum requirement of 5 registered students to be made available. Please also note that changes in subjects offered for each academic year is at the school's discretion and may be changed at any point prior to the start of the academic year.
