



Committees

Cold Spring HSA has a variety of committees and many opportunities for parents and caregivers to get involved. If you wish to join any committee, please email coldspringhsa@gmail.com and a board member will connect you with the relevant committee chair.

Apparel

This committee organizes school spirit wear sales, usually twice per year. Coordinators and members of this committee collaborate to design and choose the apparel for each sale, create order forms and coordinate and distribute orders to students.

Book Fair

This committee organizes the annual book fair that takes place at the start of each school year. The committee works with a designated book fair company and the school Librarian to coordinate the event. Volunteers assist with book sales, restock books and assist students with their purchases during the fair.

Bulletin Board

This committee is responsible for decorating and updating the Home & School bulletin board in the school hallway. The bulletin board is usually themed to correspond with a season or holiday and displays information about upcoming events.

Bingo

This popular family fun event usually takes place in January. The committee is responsible for advertising, organizing prizes, volunteers to work the event and selling refreshments.

Father/Someone Special - Daughter Event

A favorite event for all the Cold Spring girls! Committee members organize all aspects of planning this special event including theme, decor, advertising, food, entertainment, ticket sales and coordination of volunteers. This event typically takes place in school in February.

Mother/Someone Special - Son Event

One for the boys! Committee members are responsible for all aspects of planning including venue selection, advertising, ticket sales, participants and volunteer sign up. This event typically takes place in school in March.

Garden Club

Committee members work with a teacher advisor to coordinate Fall and Spring weeding, clean up and new planting. They also assist with Bucket Day in the Spring.

Holiday Shop

This seasonal pop-up shop allows the students to shop for their family's holiday gifts at designated times for one day only in December. Committee members organize inventory, advertising and coordination of volunteers to sell and assist students with shopping and purchases on the day.

Hospitality

Coordinators and committee members organize special meals and tokens of appreciation for teachers, staff and faculty throughout the school year, including a Welcome Back Breakfast, Spring Conferences and Teacher Appreciation week in May. Responsibilities include menu planning, coordination of parent volunteers, food donations and execution of the various events.

International Night

This event takes place in April and celebrates different food and cultures within our community. The event is free to families. Committee members take care of advertising, coordinating signups for participants and volunteers for the evening.

Pretzel Day

Pretzel Day typically takes place on the last Friday of each month. Students can purchase a soft pretzel for \$1, or families can pre-pay for the whole year in advance. Committee chairs organize the monthly sale, order the pretzels and volunteers to help serve the pretzels.

5th / 6th Grade Social Club

Coordinators and committee members plan and organize several special social events for students in their final school year. Parent volunteers get involved in selecting venues and plan events, including advertising, ticket sales, participant registration and coordinating volunteers at the activity.

Spring Fair

This is one of the main fundraising events that takes place each year. Coordinators and committee members plan all aspects of this family fun event, including sponsorship, theming, entertainment, food, raffle baskets and silent auction. Volunteers are required at the event for food and ticket sales, supervision of activities and helping with raffle.

Yearbook

Coordinators of the Yearbook committee work with a designated yearbook company to agree the design and layout of the annual yearbook. Committee members take photographs at all major school events and parties throughout the year, and coordinate with families to send in pictures and material to include. The committee also coordinates advertising, sales and distribution of the yearbook.

In addition, each grade level has designated photographers that take pictures at classroom parties and various other events to submit to the Yearbook. Please reach out to the Yearbook Committee directly by email if you would like to help with the yearbook.
