2.0 Discussion/Action Items

2.1) Take action to approve '2024-25 Annual Report on Measure M'

Per TUHSD PTCOC bylaws, an Annual Report produced by the PTCOC is to be presented to the TUHSD Board of Trustees, currently scheduled for October 28th, reviewing and confirming that the district expenditures of Measure M were expended as authorized by the voter-approved ballot measure language.

C. Elsen shared key changes were:

- **Funding amounts for the 2024-2025 school year were updated Measure M Parcel Tax Rate was \$528.54 per parcel , and annual amount collected was \$17,969,731**

C. Elsen shared senior exemptions for 2024-2025. Reviewed tabs from previous years and shared the breakdown of departments for all sites on the spreadsheet. Shared the total amounts of the funding matches the total of expenditures. There are no carry over expenditures from the 2024-2025 school year.

B. Levinson shared appreciation of teacher salary breakdown as a valuable tool to show accountability and matching expenditures to Measure M goals.

2.2) Discuss 1) 2025-26 TUHSD Budget Adoption & 2) 2024-25 Unaudited Actuals budget report presentation

C. Elsen shared budget adoption and unaudited actuals highlighting key slides. Noting financial impacts to the budget. Several factors have contributed to the financial outlook including increased expenditures especially in healthcare rates and utilities, impact of imposed tariffs especially on steel and aluminium, and reduced property tax revenue growth rates.

Budget reduction has been impacted by less property tax revenue and federal education funding and continued enrollment declines. Potential staffing reductions as enrollment continues to decline, input and discussions regarding rightsizing district programs to align with enrollment and financial realities.

PTCOC members asked clarifying questions regarding rightsizing programs and impacts of financials regarding declining enrollment numbers.

PTCOC members further reviewed federal funding on Title 1-4 programs in the unaudited actuals, noting an estimated potential \$2.2 Million in budget reductions.

C. Elsen provided a brief update on the new Superintendent, Dr. Courtney Goode, who began his role in July. Dr. Goode is looking forward to attending the Committee Meeting in April to meet all members.

3.2) Update on TUHSD facilities bond (Measure B)

C. Elsen shared Summer 2025 Facilities Projects updated. Shared Measure B visuals regarding updates to RHS Pool Replaster Project, RHS Ghilotti Field Re-Turf Project, RHS FASCD Project, and THS STEAM Project. In addition, shared Non- Bond related updates including RHS Solar Project, RHS Temporary Parking, and AWHs Tennis Courts Project that are now complete. Finally, shared Summer 2026 Planned Projects including updating IT improvements.
