Servite High School is accredited by the Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA) and the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).



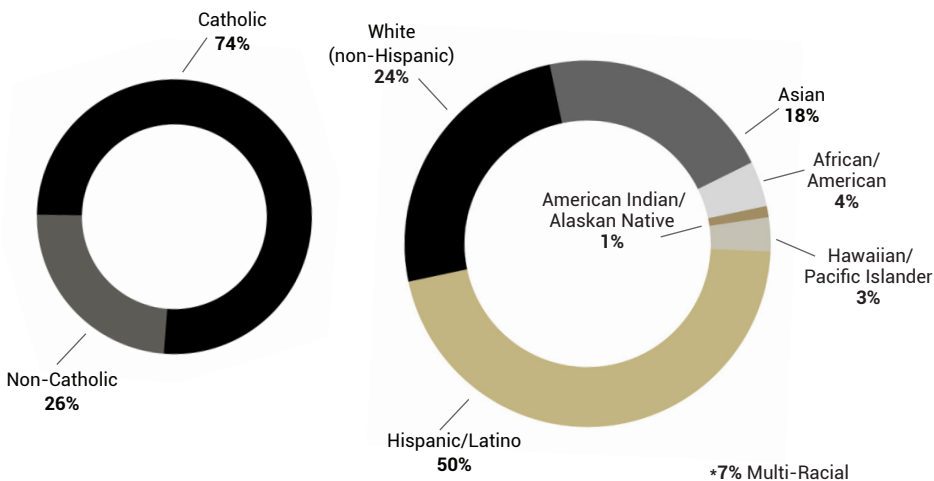
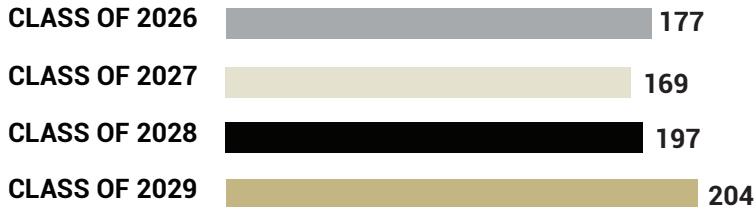

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate from Servite High School, members of the graduating classes of 2027 and beyond are required to complete 260 academic credits.

A one-year course meeting daily earns a student 10 academic credits.

STANDARDIZED TESTING

AP TESTING

Over the last five years, an average of 76% of test takers have earned a passing score of 3 or better.

AWARD LEVELS

PRINCIPAL'S HIGH HONOR ROLL WITH DISTINCTION

Students with no semester grade lower than an A- in any course AND at least three (3) HP/AP-level courses in their schedule. For freshmen only who are enrolled in either Full Honors, Math/Science, or Liberal Honors track; Ninth-grade students with no semester grade lower than an A- in any course, AND at least two HP-level courses

PRINCIPAL'S HIGH HONOR ROLL

Students with a minimum of 3.80 semester weighted GPA, *be in good academic standing, and have no grade lower than a C-.

PRINCIPAL'S HONOR ROLL

Students with a minimum 3.50 semester weighted GPA, *be in good academic standing, and have no grade lower than a C-.

COMPUTER SCIENCE PATHWAY

PATHWAY REQUIREMENTS:

- Summer before freshman year: Complete a Fine Art course.
- Eligible for or have completed Algebra 2/Trig by end of sophomore year.
- Completion of a capstone project by end of senior year.

Individuals will receive recognition and honors for successfully completing this pathway.

FORMATION

Formation is the intentional, systematic direction of the complete student experience toward a development of the whole, unique person – body and soul. The entire process is centered on one insistent question: "Who are you?"



ATHLETICS

Servite offers 14 CIF team sports in the Trinity League and 2 club sports. Servite's competitive programs have resulted in college scholarships to Division I, II, III, and NAIA schools.



PRIORY LEADERSHIP

This unique leadership program incorporates the entire school through 2x-monthly class periods in the middle of the school day where students lead their classmates through various competitions, activities, and life-skill lessons. The curriculum is designed to highlight the different gifts of our student body and provide a laboratory for an enhanced understanding of the Formation Themes.

CURRICULUM

All courses offered at Servite High School are designed for the college and university-bound student. One school year includes two 18-week semesters. Students are required to attend a minimum of seven academic courses per day every semester except for seniors when 6 are required.

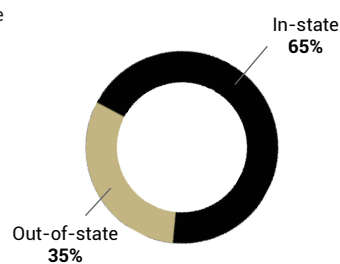
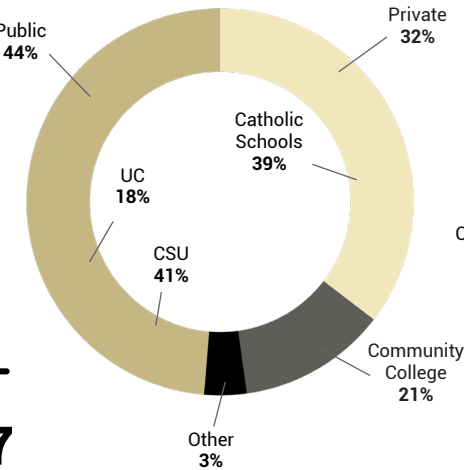
