### **Curriculum Notes**

**Math:** Students will understand multiplicative comparison and begin using visual models for multi-digit multiplication.

**Accelerated Math:** Students will use place value knowledge to round, add, and subtract decimals.

**ELA:** (Grammar & Writing) Students will be able to identify and use correct subjects and predicates. Students will analyze sources and plan to write an expository essay.

**Reading:** Students will analyze a novel written in poetic verse and recognize the author's poetic techniques (rhyme, structure, figurative language). Students will identify character traits within a poem.

**Social Studies:** Students will share their knowledge of the new nation and its government.

**Student Success Skills/ReThink:** Students will understand how friendship brings us a sense of belonging.
