CTRA Decision Day '24 erupted with applause when it was announced that Princess Lewis would head to Smith College that fall - and through early decision admission!

Princess came to Goodwin Magnet School System having attended Odyssey Community School in Manchester for the previous eight years. She recalls having some apprehension about leaving Odyssey to attend CTRA.

“So it was definitely a big change because I was with the same group of people for such a long time. So it was a whole new school, new people. None of my friends from my old school came to CTRA,” Princess recalls. “definitely new, but like I got close to a lot of people quickly. It was such a nice community.”

Princess remembers the many CTRA teachers, counselors, and advisors Educators that walked with her as she journeyed through the high school years. Of CTRA Principal, Princess recounts, “Mr. Foster. I remember him greeting me every single day when I came in. So, that just like set the tone for the day - a friendly face that I knew every single day.”

Princess credits her time at CTRA for helping prepare her for college in two important ways. One is by introducing her to a world of different cultures. “I got the opportunity to meet a lot of new people from different cultures and backgrounds.” The other is helping her prepare for college.

Princess recalls some of the many college-bound activities offered at CTRA, “We had a lot of workshops during school during my study halls where we got to apply for scholarships. We worked on Common App and FASA. So, it helped me with financial aid, as well as to apply, and my college essay.”

She also recalled how participating in CTRA’s dual enrollment program, the opportunity to take free college level courses while going to high school, helped her prepare for college, “Goodwin which definitely prepared me for college because of all the coursework that I did with them. So, I feel like there are so many different components of Goodwin that helped me prepare for college and getting ready for a more rigorous [academic] pace.” By graduation day, Princess had earned 21 college level credits.

With her first year of college successfully completed, both academically and socially, Princess looks forward to returning to Smith College to pursue her studies and to explore new worlds there.

To those scholars everywhere Princess offers this sage advice, “I know sometimes that school can be difficult, and it can be like some challenges and setbacks, which I've had a lot of, but just as long as you keep at...it will be worth it in the end.”
