## Drains are only for rain!

- ✓ Dispose of paint and motor oil at the West Hartford Recycling Center, or other certified locations.
- ✓ Take part in Household Hazardous Waste Collection, held twice per year.
- ✓ Collect pet waste and dispose of in the trash.
- ✓ Wash vehicles at a commercial car wash.
- ✓ Drain pool water to the sanitary sewer.



## West Hartford Stormwater is **not treated**.

### Roadway drains connect directly to local waterways.

Whether rain or snowmelt, water runoff picks up pollutants from pavement and yards and carries them to local waterways where they can harm wildlife and the environment.
