- Liaison between schools and communities for families
 - · referrals e.g. mental health, housing assistance, clothing closets, healthcare
 - home visits
- tier 1 student support groups (not usually the IEP kids who already have groups they participate in)
- PIT crew (pre-referral intervention team) to discuss teacher-referred students who might need assistance or begin the IEP process
- Both pre-emptive and in response to observed behavior. Students take SABERS assessment. Parents can come to her with questions.
