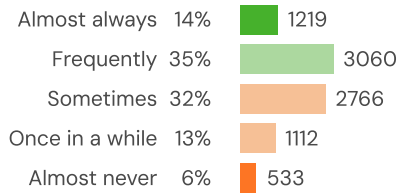

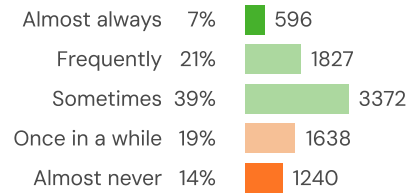
Q.1: How often do teachers encourage you to learn about people from different races, ethnicities, or cultures?

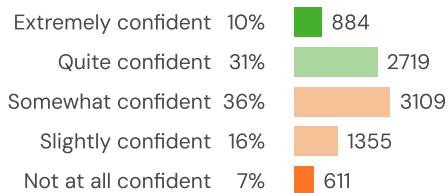
Q.2: How often do you think about what someone of a different race, ethnicity, or culture experiences?

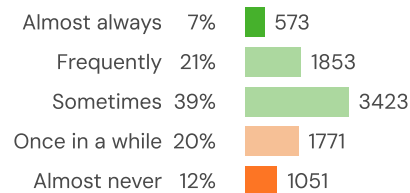
Q.3: How confident are you that students at your school can have honest conversations with each other about race?

Q.4: At your school, how often are you encouraged to think more deeply about race-related topics?

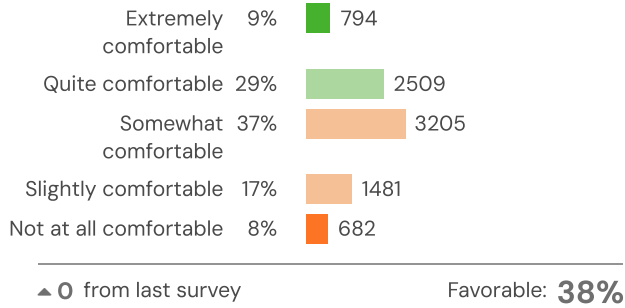

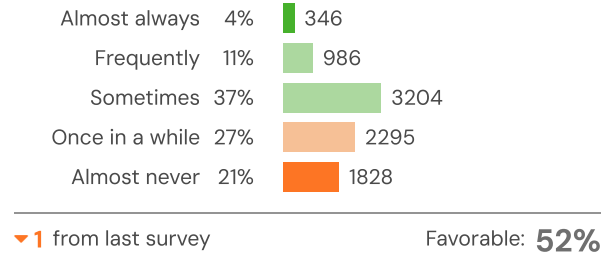

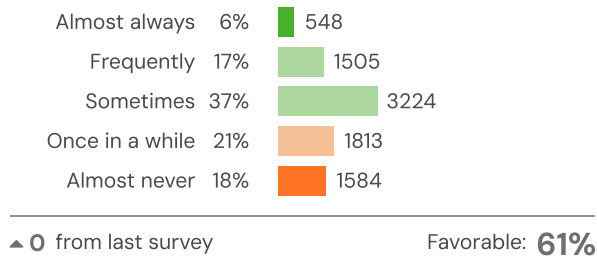
Q.5: How comfortable are you sharing your thoughts about race-related topics with other students at your school?



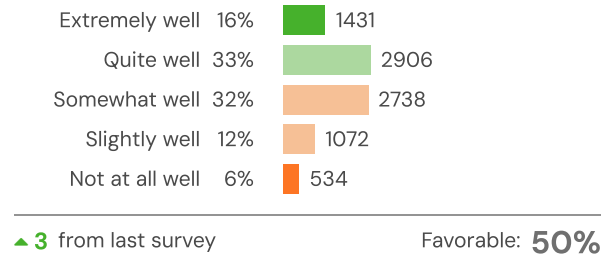
Q.6: How often do students at your school have important conversations about race, even when they might be uncomfortable?

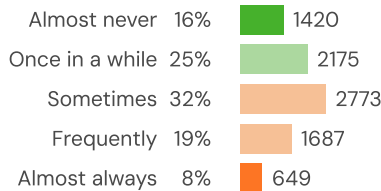

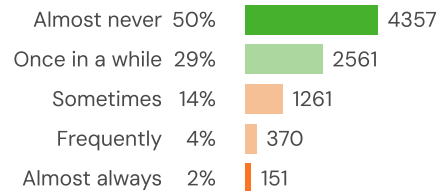
Q.1: How often are people disrespectful to others at your school?

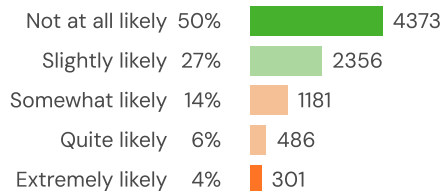
Q.2: How often do students get into physical fights at your school?

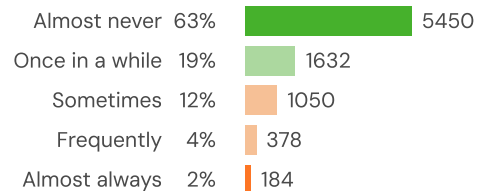
Q.3: How likely is it that someone from your school will bully you online?

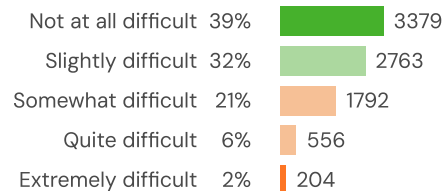
Q.4: How often do you worry about violence at your school?

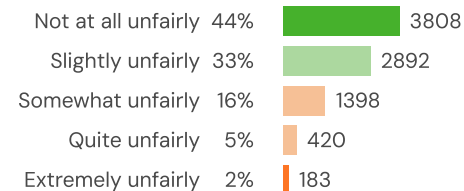
Q.5: If a student is bullied in school, how difficult is it for him/her to get help from an adult?

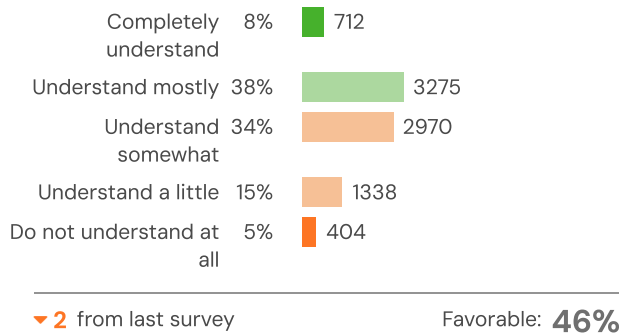

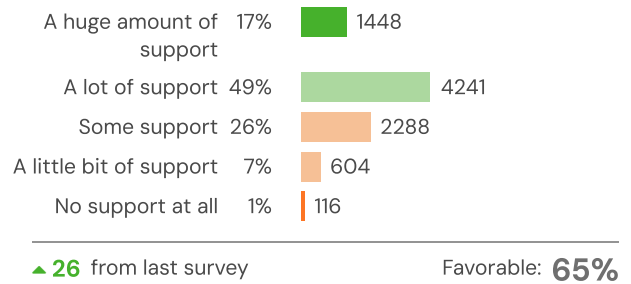

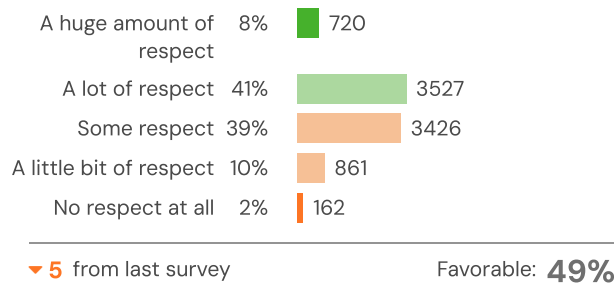
Q.1: How well do people at your school understand the kind of person you are?



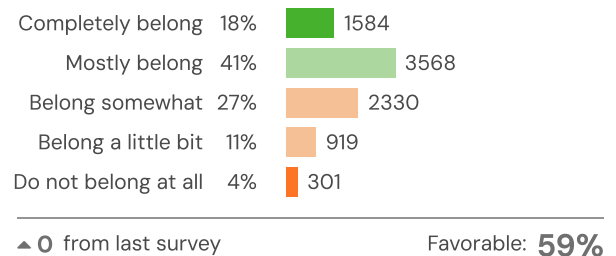
Q.2: How much support do the adults at your school give you?

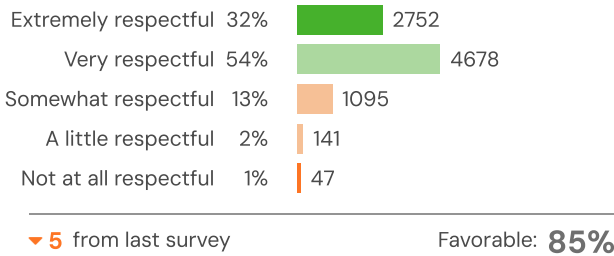

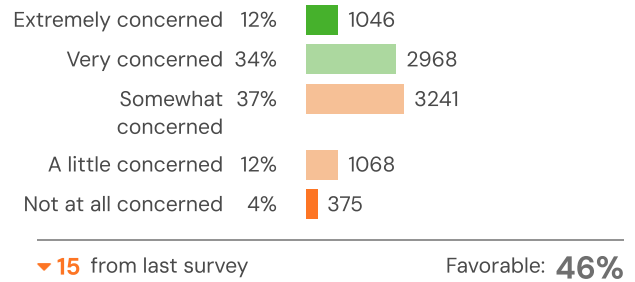

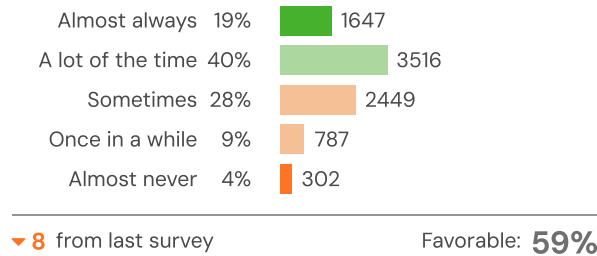
Q.1: How respectful are your teachers towards you?
