Community & Environment

School & Education

Reading buddies (older students read with younger students), Homework helpers or tutoring, Book or school supply drives, Kindness notes campaign

Helping Others

Food drives for local pantries, Make care kits (toiletries, socks, snacks) for shelters, Blanket or scarf making for hospitals or homeless shelters, Holiday card or letter writing for nursing homes, veterans, or first responders, Toy drives or gently-used clothing collections

Animals

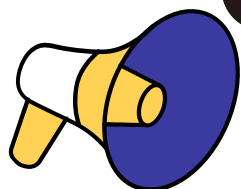
Collect supplies (blankets, food, toys) for local shelters, Make dog toys from old T-shirts
